SENIORS

Wallan vs Woodend Heskett

Last time they met it was cat and mouse. Woodend Heskett got on top early, Wallan pegged them back then Woodend Heskett fought back. If the final is anything like their last meeting its going to be an exciting contest for everyone to watch.

The teams split the results this season but with a win over Woodend Heskett and another finals contender in Riddell, Wallan will go into this one as favourites.

From the Coaches:

Wallan: It's really pleasing to finish the season second on the ladder. We had a transition with our list over the Summer and injected a lot of youth which was exciting for the club. The future is really bright and we are ready for the challenge of finals footy.

The last two weeks we have played quality opposition and came away with close wins. We trailed throughout both games however the boys just don't give up, they stay calm and remain positive. It's a coachable group and I'm looking forward to seeing further improvement and development in finals. Woodend have talent all over the park. Especially tails. They have a great combination in the ruck with Martin and Toman in the midfield. Plus the likes of Rae, Gawthrop, Arceri and Pound.

Our forward line is starting to take shape with Pez, Jacob Langbourne, Micky Baccari and Toddy Muldoon all playing pivotal roles. The backline continue to play discipline football. Captain Michael Mannix has led from the front recently, closely followed by Morris, Viani, Layley and the Gilchrist' Baccari and Langborne brothers.

Woodend Heskett: It is really exciting for our group. We have all three teams in finals and its been a long time coming in the seniors. We don't want to get to far ahead of ourselves

we are excited but there is a lot of work still to be done. We have a second chance so it is a free swing at Wallan this week. We were really competitive against them a few weeks ago and really just didn't play a full four quarters. It is going to be a big challenge but we are certainly up for it and we have nothing to lose.

Players to watch

Wallan: Michael Mannix has been in great form and he is another player who doesn't lack finals experience. With a young group his leadership will be crucial to the Magpies this weekend.

Woodend Heskett: Daniel Toman has been a stand out all season long and we expect him to take his football to another level in the finals.

Prediction: Woodend Heskett to go through and meet Diggers Rest in the second semi next week.

Riddell vs Romsey

Romsey just over Lancefield to book their spot in the finals for 2023 the same team that defeated Riddell the week earlier.

Riddell come into finals on the back of two tough losses and will be looking to turn things around quickly. No second chances for either of these teams.

From the Coaches:

Riddell: We are not in the best form when you look at our results. We haven't played bad football though. We still think we have what it takes to win it but we know its going to be bloody tough from fourth. It's a really competitive top five you cant have a bad game in the next month. Romsey have some star players and we need to be mindful of them but we just need four good quarters and that will leave us in good stead.

Romsey: It is great to be a part of the RDFNL finals in 2023. We have had a pretty good year and some results didn't fall our way but we have always felt like we were in the top five

Players to watch

Romsey: Jack Jedwab was their main man last weekend not only did he kick four goals but on 14 occasions he was involved when Romsey scored. He is their play maker in the forward line.

Prediction: Riddell to progress through to the second week.

RESERVES

Wallan vs Romsey

The Wallan Reserves are the backbone of the club and they are super proud of them finishing top three and getting a second chance. Matty Traynor is having another sensational year plus Damian Korp, Blaide Dickson, Daniel Perkins and the silky smooth Rhys Frost. 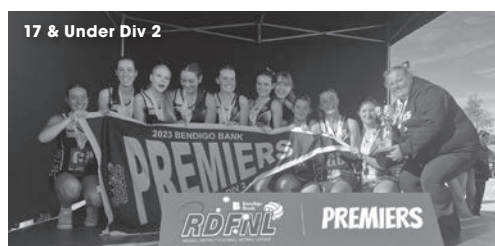


