FINALS WEEK 2 PREVIEWS

SENIORS

Fresh from a first week bye we will get our first look at Diggers Rest for this final series when they take on Wallan. Both teams are no stranger to finals having met not once but twice in 2022.

Wallan got a big lead in their qualifying final against Woodend Heskett and despite a late charge they were able to hold their composure and get the win.

Diggers Rest have had the chance to freshen up both mentally and physically.

The winner of this one books their spot on the biggest day of the year.

Diggers Rest vs Wallan

From the Coaches:

Diggers Rest: It has been good to freshen up mentally and physically and we are ready to play finals. We are excited to have a full list to choose from but there are going to be some hard luck stories. We had 49 players on the track this week and we would love to say they could all play but that's not football. Wallan are a different team to who we played during the year. They have got some players in but they have lost Boyal. I think we match up well against Wallan. Despite what people are saying we are quite young and have plenty of speed. We are keen to get into the best part of the season and the RDNFL was a bit of a buzz at the minute. Our club is really excited about the prospect of having another strong team enter if that is to come to fruition but we have a job to do first.

Wallan: This group just continues to prove people wrong and they never give up, especially when challenged. With so many young players coming through our system, these boys just stay calm and remain positive. We train to control momentum at times but a huge focus is having an ability to remain focused during tight games. They believe in each other and the process. It's a really good group to Coach. It's a fun squad, who just have a crack and play an attacking game style. Young Riley Gilchrist was super in the midfield and Corey Viani and Sean Morris were both strong over the footy. Hayden Gill competed extremely well against Martin in the Ruck. Mannix controlled the footy behind the play and our Half Backs provided plenty of run and carry. Pez was lively up Forward. Woodend are a quality side and we knew they would come. Once they got some momentum, it was pleasing to see the players fight back. We have a good mix of youth and senior experience. Woodend are tall and we respect them highly. This week is a big test, playing the flag favorites in Diggers. They finished on top for a reason

and are coming off the bye. Match ups will be crucial and simply having individuals playing their roles will be crucial. I have faith in my boys. They are playing outstanding team football at the moment and sticking to the game plan.

Players to watch

Diggers Rest: Rumour has it Mitch Jensen is finally fit and ready to play four quarters of senior football. We know how good he can be but will he come into the game underdone?

Wallan: Matt Perri is a sharp shooter who is finding form at the right time of year.

Prediction: Diggers Rest have had one slip up all season long. They have looked the goods against the Magpies both times and I can't see them letting this one slip.

Woodend Heskett vs Romsey

Woodend Heskett will be keen to bounce back from their week one finals performance. The Hawks showed they are capable but a poor second quarter saw Wallan run away with it and despite challenging late and hitting the front the Hawks were unable to hang on. Romsey came home strong to knock out Riddell who were the higher placed team.

From the Coaches:

Woodend Heskett: Very proud of the boys to get ourselves back in the game after half time but disappointed that we let ourselves lapse so much in the second quarter and be so far back. Romsey were impressive on Sunday and played really well at our ground when we played them late in the season so not sure how much of an advantage the home ground will give us. We might have a change or two. Will see how the week pans out at training and at this stage it is likely to be Stapleton that goes to Jedwab but yet to be confirmed.

Romsey: It was a great win. We took it the distance and got the reward. We really did save our best football until last. We know it's been our challenge all year. We have played three quarters of good football and been competitive but we haven't got the results. I didn't want to put the pressure on the boys I just asked them to enjoy the moment and give it everything. If everything was good enough then we could live with that but we didn't want to go out and have regrets. What a game of football it was though. I reckon it was a really good spectacle. Both teams had moments it was high scoring, fast and tough. One door closes and another opens though. We turn our attention to Woodend Heskett and we have a huge amount of respect for them. They are very well coached. We need to recover well and

We are really proud to have three teams playing in football and some netball and lucky that they are all together. It should be a great day for the club. We are strong in that we don't need a superstar we just need everyone to play a role. The 22 we had on the weekend were all great at playing their role and I don't think we will be making too many changes.

Players to watch

Woodend Heskett: Tim Martin comfortably won the ruck battle last week and is a key player for sending the Hawks into attack.

Romsey: Nathan Rayment was our player of the week again this week for his contested work and finishing with three goals he is a crucial player for the Redbacks.

Prediction: Romsey have been close to Woodend Heskett both times and they play Gilbert Gordon well. This is going to be a great game. Woodend Heskett just.

RESERVES

Diggers Rest vs Wallan

Like their senior team Diggers Rest get their first taste of finals football in the second week after a week off. They will have plenty of class and senior football experience in their reserves and it is a good mix of youth and experience.

Wallan were too strong in their game against Romsey last week.

Matty Traynor and Damian Korp have been huge all year plus Blaide Dickson and Daniel Perkins relished in finals action.

Prediction: Diggers Rest to get the win over Wallan.

Romsey vs Woodend

Romsey fell short against Wallan in week one of the finals and have found themselves in an elimination final against Woodend Heskett.

They will take some confidence from the result though as they finished the game well kicking four goals to two in the final term.

Romsey's Angus Storey and Josh Smiley stood up under pressure and were two of the better players.

Woodend Heskett led from start to finish.

Ethan Gove was one of the big contributors but the

Hawks had plenty of winners across the ground as they easily accounted for Riddell.

Prediction: Romsey to keep their season alive.

UNDER 19.5

Gisborne Giants vs Macedon

Gisborne Giants finished on top of the ladder and earned the week off. Macedon finished third and had to beat Romsey to find themselves in the second semi.

Several of the Macedon players have already featured in finals at junior level and it is holding them in good stead.

Michael Rutledge dominated with six goals but he was one of only two goal kickers for the day for the Cats.

They may need another avenue to goal this weekend.

For the Giants they have a spearhead of their own up forward with Nathan Hynes averaging three goals a game this season.

Gisborne will be the favourites going in but finals are a different ball game and having finals experience under your belt could be invaluable.

Prediction: Macedon to cause an upset and go through the grand final.

Romsey vs Wallan

Romsey finished higher than their first week opponent but it wasn't to be now they find themselves in a do or die final.

Bailey Cecati played well for the Redbacks but needed more support.

Charlie Jedwab made the most of his opportunities with two goals up forward.

Romsey will look to move a few of their senior players back to the 19s this week. The Redbacks have all three teams playing on Sunday and senior coach Justin Sherman said they wouldn't be burning players out across two grades if it could be avoided.

For Wallan Max Russell was one of Wallan's better players on the ground in their win over Woodend Heskett. He is strong, runs all day and wins the contested ball.

Archie Moore also played well in the ruck and Marcus Datson was excellent up forward with 4 goals.

Prediction: Romsey to sneak over the line and end Wallan's season.

GREATER WESTERN WATER NETBALL REPORT by RDFNL Netball Manager Grace Bibby

Finals make for some interesting lessons on leadership and performance, and these apply equally to business and life overall.

Last week, I had the chance to observe first hand the dynamics of winning and losing at the RDFNL Senior Finals.

Whereas the early rounds of competition were about separating out the more talented teams from the less, the later rounds were all about the differences in their ability to perform under pressure. That's where it got really interesting. As we watched equally talented teams either wilt under the pressure or rise to the occasion, the word that kept cropping up from the players themselves to the coaches and also my fellow spectators was: composure. This seemed to encapsulate the difference between winning and losing at the top level of the competition and even more so on Sunday for our Elimination Finals.

So how do we define composure? The dictionary says it is a "serene, self-controlled state of mind; calmness; tranquillity." In the context of finals level competition, it means the ability to keep a cool head and perform to your full potential under pressure; it's about being able to make and execute on the same decisions in the same way when under pressure as when there is no pressure at all.

We saw teams get frazzled and fall apart as the competition got tougher ("they didn't keep their composure") whereas they had played as a well-oiled unit earlier in the season. We watched individual players work hard to get the ball up the court and finally break free but the goalers weren't able to convert and we saw defenders create turn overs and then give it straight back while others seemed to revel in the intensity of the moment and make heroic shots and come up with intercepts against all odds.

Imagine what we could achieve if each of us could be so much in our element when the going gets tough — if our environment could have no adverse effect on our performance at that crucial client meeting or when speaking in front of hundreds of our peers.

So how do we improve our composure? How can we sustain peak performance under increasing pressure? Part of this ability is intrinsic, and some people are simply born with it. But fortunately for the rest of us, much of it can be acquired through self-awareness, experience and training.

1. Stay Passionate but Don't Allow Your Emotions to Get in the Way

Seasoned leaders know that passion is everything and burying their emotions is futile. But that doesn't mean we can wear our emotions on our sleeves, especially when cooler heads must prevail. Don't yell or get overly animated when times get tough. Keep positive body language.

2. Keep a Positive Mental Attitude

Opposition are always watching their leader's actions, behaviour, relationships and overall demeanour. During the most difficult of times, leaders must maintain a positive mental attitude and manage a narrative that keeps their teammates inspired and hopeful. This is where your leadership experience and resolve can really shine — by staying strong, smiling often and authentically exhibiting a sense of compassion. Leaders set the tone for the team and club they serve. A positive attitude can neutralize chaos and allow a leader to course correct through any negativity even if the game is not going their way.

3. Remain Courageous

During uncertain times, leaders must remain fearless. I've been through ups and downs in my career and have learned that when you begin to fear adverse circumstances, you not only put yourself in a position of vulnerability, but it becomes extremely difficult to act rationally and focus. When you panic, you mentally freeze. If you begin to get fearful, ask yourself: What is the worst possible thing that can happen? When you have the will and confidence to face that, you will realize that the situation is manageable and can be resolved. If you are a shooter don't stop shooting the ball because you are worried it will miss.

4. Take Accountability

Leaders should be most composed during times of crisis and change and be fully committed to resolving the issue at hand. When they are accountable, this means that they have made the decision to assume responsibility and take the required steps to problem solve before the situation gets out of hand. When leaders assume accountability, they begin to neutralize the problem and place the environment from which it sprung on pause.

It's easy to lose composure during finals especially if you let concern turn into worry and worry turn into fear. By maintaining composure, the best leaders remain calm, cool and in control — enabling them to step back, critically evaluate the cards that they have been dealt and face problems head-on. A show of composure also puts those you lead at ease and creates a safe and secure culture where no one needs to panic when the heat is on.

We are looking forward to being on the sidelines again this weekend to see which teams and individuals will stand up under pressure.

Please remember everyone is entitled to an opinion but if it may insult someone else please keep it to yourself.

We want RDFNL to be a safe place for people to enjoy netball as players, coaches, umpires and spectators.
