Diggers Rest vs Riddell

The battle of last years premiers. While both teams look different it means something to the supporters of the league. Diggers Rest have not put a foot wrong all season. Riddell stumbled early and have been quietly going about their business since some senior player returned mid-season. Can Riddell upset the ladder leaders and shake things up on the eve of finals?

From the Coaches:

Diggers Rest: We are a slow starting team. We are not too worried about it at the minute. We know teams get themselves up to play us. It is always the way when there is an undefeated team sitting at the top of the ladder. Credit to our boys though they keep at it and grind their opponents down. We have had players out the past few weeks and we have been able to hold on against good opposition. We still have plenty to focus on and this week is another big test for them and us. There will be a bit of hype around the rematch but we are not looking into it. We just want to play four good quarters.

Riddell: They were too good for us early in the season and we knew then we had to make some changes. We are still confident we can beat them but it is not going to be easy. We have been ticking along nicely and if we want to be there late in September this is a game we should be able to win. We are fresh off the bye and ready to lift again for the last three games.

Players to watch

Diggers Rest: Mark Orr returns from an overseas holiday in time for a big clash.

Riddell: Dylan Tarczon loves the big stage and will be ready to shoulder a lot of the workload this weekend.

Prediction: Diggers Rest to win after a big challenge from last years premiers.

Macedon vs Melton Centrals

This is as big a game as it gets for two teams desperate to make finals. The race for the final spot in the top five is down to three teams. Mathematically it is possible for Melton Central but they have the hardest run home of any club in the league. Macedon have a slightly easier run but will still need to be playing their best football to play finals. The old eight point game strikes again.

From the Coaches:

Macedon: It was a good win. We controlled most of the first half then broke the game open in the 3rd quarter 5 goals to zero which enabled us to manage some players in the last. Centrals have had some great wins this season home and away plus I thought they played super well the last fortnight against Wallan and Woodend without getting the wins. We have to go in confident off the back of some of the stuff we have been doing well and these are the games the players want to compete in. The boys are holding up pretty well despite the grind of the ground condition. We should get Bulluss, Dyer, Kernan and Knox back this week which is a real positive.

Melton Centrals: We are really disappointed with the result. We let ourselves down. We just didn't make the most of our opportunities. We won the inside 50 battle but didn't get the cash. It was set shots. Not under too much pressure and goals we would normally kick but it just wasn't to be. We believe our finals chances are all but gone but we will keep fighting to make sure this is a successful season. Macedon got us early in the year and we want to level that up and break even on the season. We know we have a tough run home but we will keep fighting it out.

Players to watch

Macedon: Jack Kernan is a big inclusion having not played since late April.

Melton Centrals: Sam Apineru was back in the line up for his first run in several weeks and will be better for having a game under his belt.

Prediction: Melton Centrals to keep their slim chances of finals alive for another week with an upset win over the Cats.

Western Rams vs Lancefield

This is the battle of the bottom two placed teams. We know both teams have improved significantly this season. For Rams they have been struck down with injury while Lancefield are getting close to full strength.

From the Coaches:

Western Rams: We had a tough week last week. We just couldn't get any momentum in our half of the ground. Romsey played well. Lancefield have been very competitive against the top teams this year. We know where we are at. We will keep bleeding players and finding positives to build on for the future. As we have said all year we just want to play our best football and hopefully that can compete with Lancefield this weekend.

Lancefield: We played a really good last quarter. But to start with we were horrible. I watched it back and I actually wanted to throw up we were that bad. We were just really flat. I gave a bit of a spray and we come good but we were never in it after that start. We can't afford to do that this weekend. We want to get out of the blocks early and put a score on the board. We know we can't play finals but we can finish the year with our heads high if we can get a win here and a scalp over the last fortnight. Over the next week or so we should be as close as we have been all year to full strength.

Players to watch

Western Rams: Dean Galea continues to crack in for the Rams.

Lancefield: Zach Webb is a few games back from injury and looks to be returning to some of his best form to finish the season.

Prediction: Lancefield to record their third win of the season.

Woodend Hesket vs Romsey

A win over Melton Centrals and some results going their way was enough to see the Hawks move into second spot on the ladder. Wallan and Riddell are hot on their heels just one game away. The Hawks know how important it is to have a second chance and they will be hungry for the win this weekend. Romsey will be just as hungry as they try to lock away fifth spot.

From the Coaches:

Woodend Hesket: we knew how important the weekends game was for centrals season and that they would be at their best. Felt like we controlled a good portion of the game but we were poor late in the game and we're lucky to hold on in certain elements. Credit to the group for getting the 4 points nonetheless. Our first outing versus Romsey I'd say was probably our most complete game for the season and the game was still close so we are under no illusions how tough the game will be.

Romsey: We needed a really good win to get some belief back after a tough few weeks. We have three big weeks of football to get through now before we start worrying about finals. Every game to finish the season is like a final for us. We know we need a few more wins to get through but this group want to play finals this year. Woodend Hesket is going to be tough but we think we have the ability to not only compete but get the points in an upset.

Players to watch

Woodend Hesket: Al Rae kept Jack goalless in the first game so I don't think it will be a surprise to anyone that he will have that matchup.

Romsey: Jack Jedwab was our player of the week for his 10 goal haul but he didn't just dominate in front of goals he also took 17 marks and led all players for possessions.

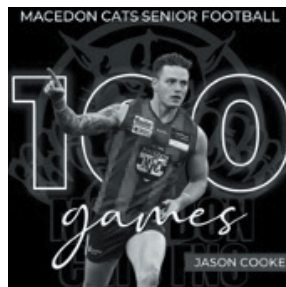

WESTERN WATER NETBALL REPORT

by RDFNL Netball Manager Grace Bibby

It's a challenge for all coaches, and not just at the local level to start the game well.

What can we do to help our players ensure they're switched on and ready to put strong netball out on court in the opening minutes of a game all the while containing their adrenaline or pre game jitters.

Here are a few simple ideas worth considering thanks to the netball coach blog:

BUILD THROUGH THE WARM-UP

This is arguably the most common contributing factor in teams that consistently start games slowly - they're simply not ready to go, and it all stems from the pre-game warm-up.

Does your team spend the first 10 minutes of warm-up chatting, doing their exercises at half-pace and stretching poorly, followed by more chatting while they warm up their passing, and then eventually lifting their heart rate a little when they move into a team drill?

If players have barely broken a sweat in warm-up, how do we then expect them to step out on court and instantly go from 0 to 100?

Try thinking of your warm-up as an extension of the game - the first of five quarters. Build the intensity through the warm-up, aiming to hit close to match intensity (both physically and in voice) in the last five minutes before the players step on court.

Encourage your players to get to the courts five minutes earlier and get their chatting out of the way before warm-up starts. Once you're in warm-up mode, try to ensure that any chat is game-specific.

As the coach responsible for a group of young players, it's up to you to set the tone.

MIX IT UP

While there's certainly value in having a set, structured team warm-up, changing up a drill or two every so often is a good way to ensure players aren't just going through the motions every week.

Add a different drill towards the end of the warm-up that they can perform well but also challenges them to think, and see if it helps them switch on.

GOALERS TAKE RESPONSIBILITY

Have you ever felt like you're dominating defensively and in general play during the first quarter of a game, but the scoreboard doesn't reflect it?

If your goalers aren't arriving early to put up shots for 10 minutes before the game (and practising throughout the week) don't expect them to be red

hot right out of the gate.

Speak to your goalers about accountability and how putting up pre-game shots is part of the responsibility of having GS or GA on your bib, and let's loosen up those nervy shots before the game, rather than in the first quarter.

HAVE A SET PLAY

Ever had a team you have coached who had a habit of always conceding 3-4 goals before they'd finally wake up and put one on the board.

We tried everything during warm-up, to no avail, but the solution turned out to be having a strong set play on the centre pass to start each game (or even each quarter).

Every player on the team knew that that structure was the first thing we were going to set up, and nine times out of 10 we'd get a shot out of it, which got the scoreboard ticking over and helped everyone relax.

Find a set play your team can execute consistently and effectively, and give it a go.

ENCOURAGE YOUR PLAYERS TO THINK AHEAD

Often there's a good chance your players will know some of their opposition, and particularly later in the season once you've already played most teams.

Before the game, ask your players to tell you something about the other team or an opponent they might be playing on - a strength they'll need to combat or a weakness they can look to exploit.

For some players, it will be enough to help put their brain in game mode, and get them firing early.

PRACTICE THOSE GOOD STARTS

While it can be hard to replicate your match night at training, finishing a session with some matchplay scenarios that replicate the start of a game is a concept worth trying.

Pick four attackers in positions, and tell them they have five centre passes in which to score 3-4 goals (depending on their age and ability).

After five centre passes, change the combination and start again. While it's not quite the same as match night, it does force players to be on their game from the very first centre pass, and remain focused for 2-3 minutes, which can be the difference between getting off to a great start, or a poor one.

This is definitely one for the coaches and we hope you have found it useful.

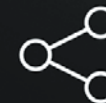

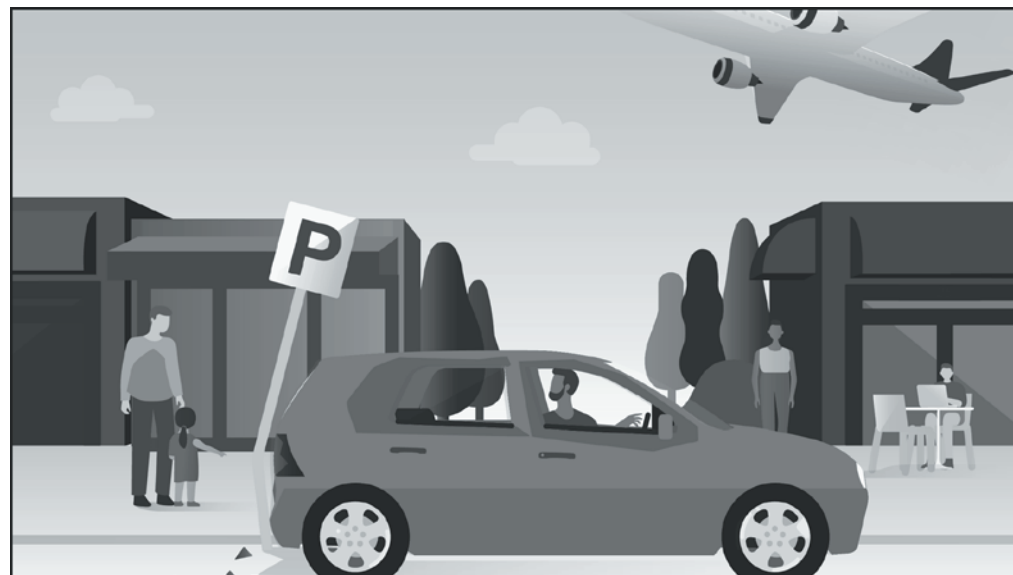
