Romsey vs Macedon

This is as exciting as it gets. Two teams fighting for one finals position. A win here will go a long way to ensuring the season doesn't end after round 18. Both teams have been playing good football. Romsey couldn't get the result last weekend but it was a game that was on a knife's edge and this will be no different.

From the Coaches:

Romsey: It is always heart breaking when you are some competitive and fall just short. It was a game that would have solidified our form and our current belief. Take nothing away from Woodend Hesket they are a very good team. We need to find one more scoring shot to turn the result around. We are still hungry and think this group can challenge in finals. We must win against the Cats.

Macedon: We were pleased with the win, we really rate the Melton midfield but we felt we won that battle which was reflected in our contested possession, groundball & clearance numbers.

Looks like we came away without any injuries and we should get Matt Knox back in after he was a late withdrawal last week. Jack Kernan got through his first game in 3 months and competed well and hit the scoreboard a few times which was great.

The Romsey match-up should be a good one, will be two pretty desperate sides I think trying to get the result. Their footy of late has been strong and ours has been building so should be a good fixture.

Players to watch

Romsey: Corey Pertzelt was best on ground in the loss and will be important for the Redbacks again this weekend.

Macedon: After withdrawing late last week Matthew Knox should come back into the team this weekend.

Prediction: Romsey to win in a close one.

Lancefield vs Wallan

Wallan have had a fortnight to rectify where it went wrong against Diggers Rest in round 14. The Magpies dominated the first quarter but Diggers Rest fought back and took the points. For Lancefield it was a strong display of football that saw them get over the line comfortable against Western Rams.

From the Coaches:

Lancefield: We played a pretty solid four quarters. Once the wind died down we really got on top and put them away. They applied some pretty tough pressure early but they ran out of legs. We want to apply pressure of our own this weekend against Wallan and hopefully string four quarters together. We moved some players around and our centre half back and centre half forward both played well at the opposite end. It is exciting to see. Western Rams vs Diggers Rest

From the Coaches:

Western Rams: It was disappoint to lose but we did apply some pressure which was good. We just couldn't sustain it for four quarters. We have some young inexperienced players at senior level who are doing a good job. You never want to play a team on the back their first loss and we know how good Diggers Rest are. Its going to be a tough game.

Players to watch

Diggers Rest: Jaycob Hickey played last weekend fresh off the plane from an overseas holiday as did Mark Orr. Both players while still fit will be better for the match fitness.

Prediction: Diggers Rest to bounce back with a big win.

Riddell vs Melton Centrals

Riddell are the hot team in the competition and their good form start when these two teams met earlier in the season and Riddell were knocked over. Both teams have had some changes to their lists due to injury since then and Riddell will be keen to keep their winning streak alive.

From the Coaches:

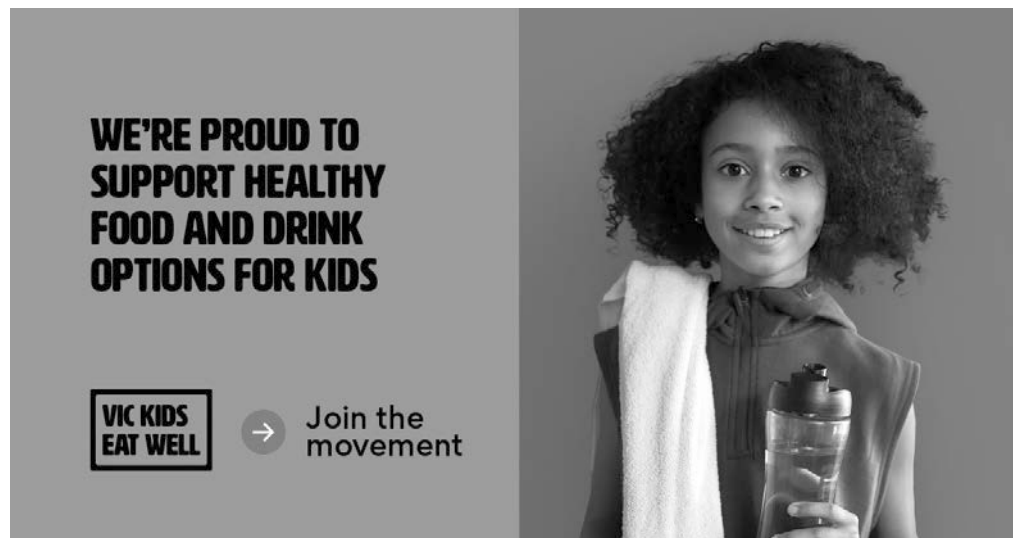

U19.5 footballers had their game against Melton Centrals forfeited.



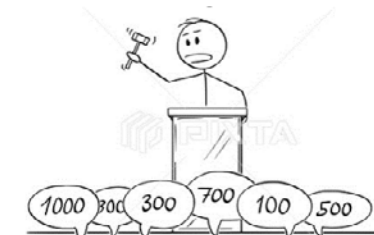

Providing more specific feedback, use of demonstration to allow players to see it being performed correctly are things you can think about using to help change the direction of your session. I can recall many sessions when it just isn't happening, so it's important that we don't just give up on it and move on to the next drill.

Similar, a player or players might just not be understanding or performing the activity correctly. Yes, it can be frustrating but as a coach it is important that you plan and cater for individual skills and abilities - which in a team sport can be difficult. Even when working within elite programs such as the State Team programs and Victorian Netball League (VNL) teams, there are times coaches have had to modify and adapt the session plan. Coaches start with Plan A, if it's not working go through to plan B and then hope and pray they don't have to go to plan C. No athlete or coach is perfect... But what we do love is the challenge which it brings, allowing coaches think on their feet to first; work out why is it not working? What is breaking down? Is it the technical ability of the players or is it the equipment we are using or even just the area in use? Once you understand the what, we need to come up with the "how to". We can do this by asking other coaches around us for advice, asking the players (especially if they are experienced player) or we can use a quick and simple model to help "Change it" when planning and running an activity or drill.

C – How can you adjust your Coaching Style?

H – How can you change the way you score

A – How can you modify the area?

N – Look at how you can adjust the numbers?

G – Can you adjust the games rules?

E – What equipment could you use?

I – Keep it about the players, make sure everyone is involved

T – Keep the duration of the activity engaging

HOW do I know when to implement the CHANGE IT concept?

- Are all the players engaged in the activity?
- Are the players being successful or achieving the objective of the activity?
- Are players being challenged for their individual and team abilities? Is it too difficult or too easy?

If after reading the above you can think of times where the answer is no, this is a great time to CHANGE IT. Remember, as the coach you are responsible for how the training session runs, however, it doesn't mean you can't listen to your athletes. Sometimes it's good to let your athletes guide the session in a different direction based on the feedback you get from. This is where CHANGE IT can work in perfectly, it also gives your athletes the feeling that they are part of the learning process. Most importantly, if the primary objective of the activity/ drill is not being met, e.g. goals not being scored or only a few players touching the ball, or skill not being performed correctly, then Change it!

If your athletes are successful during a drill or game, you may want to let the activity continue longer than originally planned, this will help to reinforce the positive results, don't be afraid to make it harder though as you can always regress the activity if the players aren't feeling success.

Here's some helpful tips to improve your ability to change, modify and adapted your activities, drills and session:

1. Personal Development – Set and monitor coaching goals, check in with a mentor or experienced coach, research and increase your resources – there are so many tools online nowadays to assist with drill ideas which might help progress or regress the drill you are having trouble with. Or book one of our Inspiring Coaching Workshops at your club <https://www.inspiresportsgroup.com/specialist-coaching-workshops/>

2. Be Flexible – Plan to abandon your plan, be prepared for lots of different circumstances, observe coaches that coach lots of different types of players, talk to them about any methods they use.

3. Empowering players – Ask players to come up with rule changes or modifications to activities, use questions to help guide player discovery to solutions, give time for group discussions to allow them to come up with the answers.

4. Creativity in Planning – Observe other sports training sessions in action and try to adapt the activities they are using to netball, bring some fun props; bean bags, hoola hoops, balloons, different types of ball, frisbee.

5. Use a Range of Coaching Styles – Set up a camera to record yourself, gain awareness of the way in which you coach, ask a mentor or experience coach to observe you in action provide feedback on things you do well and areas to continue developing.

6. Self-Reflection – De-brief with your players and co-coaches to review the session, record yourself reviewing the session in the car on the way home to yourself – listen back and record the notes.


