Melton Centrals vs Riddell

It's been a tough old start to season 2023 for both these clubs. Both teams have been hit with injury and while they have been competitive results have not fallen their way. Riddell will come into the game fresh and will have had the chance to overcome some injuries while Melton Centrals lost Sam Apineru and Ben Tyson who had just returned.

Riddell have had the tougher fixture to start the season but they need to start putting wins on the board before it is too late.

From the Coaches:

Melton Centrals: You are always disappointed when you lose so we are disappointed by the result. But you can take some confidence out of a loss and we still played some good football. Their kids played really well and were dangerous. The good sign is we are still in matches late. It is just a bad patch where we let the opposition pile on 6 or so unanswered goals. You cant do that against most sides in this league. We are trying though and we will keep trying. Credit to the boys they are really taking ownership for the first time in a long time. They care about what happens on the field and equally care what happens off the field. We know this week will once again test our depth but if we can show up, work hard we think we should be competitive.

Riddell: The bye come at a really crucial time for us. We had a lot of players playing with niggling injuries or playing out of position to protect sore bodies. We hope that the injury woes are behind us now and we can put our best foot forward to challenge the top teams towards the back end of the season. It starts this weekend. Melton Centrals have picked up a few handy players and have had their chances. We need to play a bit better than we have recently to get a win on their deck.

Players to watch

Melton Centrals: Jimmy Roberts played well last week after returning from injury. He isn't far off having a blinder.

Riddell: Josh Grabham has had a slow start to 2023 with niggling injuries. Hopefully the bye means he is fresh and ready to get back to his best.

Prediction: Riddell need a win and should get it over Melton Centrals this weekend.

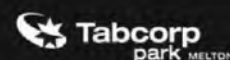

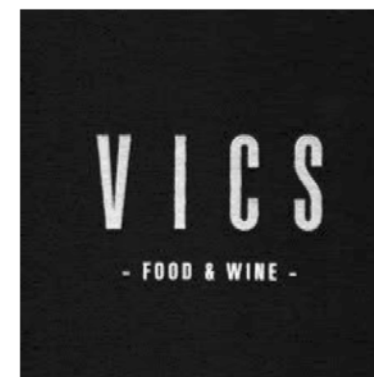

TACKLE YOUR FEELINGS



Essendon are partnering with the Tackle Your Feelings (TYF) program to make mental health training available to community coaches, in 2023. Tackle Your Feelings is a free mental health training program for community AFL coaches, as well as committee members and other club support staff. The program is delivered by a local psychologist and aims to help participants gain the tools to Understand, Recognise and Respond to signs of mental ill-health in their players. In 2021, the program was delivered to more than 4000 community coaches from 352 clubs across every Australian state and territory. 'Tackle your Feelings' was inspired by mental health education developed for AFL professional coaches and players, consisting of a face-to-face presentation from a local psychologist and additional online learning. Ambassadors include Leon Cameron, Alastair Clarkson, Nathan Buckley, Neville Jetta, Kara Antonio and Dylan Buckley also feature throughout

the video content within the program. The program was formed by the AFL Coaches Association, AFL Players' Association and Zurich Insurance in 2018, after the tragic death of Adelaide coach Phil Walsh three years earlier.

How your club can get involved

Tackle Your Feelings is a free program and is available to your club in 2023.

Once coaches complete the training (workshop and online modules) they will have access to resources including blogs, podcasts and videos to assist with their ongoing learning. Participating clubs are eligible for the Tackle Your Feelings rewards program, which includes footballs, equipment and access to program ambassadors.

WESTERN WATER NETBALL REPORT by RDFNL Netball Manager Grace Bibby

It was very disappointing to receive several phone calls and emails over the weekend from both our junior and senior competition where rough play and poor behaviour from spectators, coaches and players has ruined what was an otherwise successful weekend of netball.

We know the umpire shortage across the state continues to be an issue and if this behaviour continues the already difficult task of finding umpires will get worse.

No matter what the result is players should be humble and respectful as should coaches and spectators.

If you have found yourself dealing with players taunting other players whether it be the opposition on game day or even during the week at school, or some overly aggressive play, please use this as a reminder of how privileged we are to play sport and that the benefits of sport go far beyond winning and losing.

Participating in sport programs is a regular part of growing up, for most of us in Australia. Physical activity is essential for healthy and optimal development, through childhood and early adulthood, and youth and adult sports provide many opportunities.

The key benefits of sport include;

Providing a positive outlet where kids can spend their free time which can also help relieve boredom; one of the biggest factors in youth crime. Recreation and sport events can be a great facilitator for engagement and interaction, helping build stronger bonds within your neighbourhoods. There is no second family like your netball team and club mates.

Improving physical health; We all know that recreation, sport events and keeping physical health in tip-top shape are among the best things we can do for our overall health. Even activities such as going for a brisk walk and other moderately aerobic activities are deemed fairly safe and effective for most people.

Immediate health benefits include:

1. Better sleep quality
2. Less anxiety
3. Reduced blood pressure

Long-term health benefits include:

1. Reduced risk of developing dementia
2. Lowered risk of heart disease
3. Heightened cancer prevention
4. Weight management
5. Improved bone strength
6. Reduced risk of falls through improved balance

In general, Health experts recommended 150 minutes of moderate activity per week to lower the risk of all-cause mortality by up to 33% so if you train once or twice a week with your chosen club and play one or two games you are hitting that goal.

Learning new life skills; Sporting Clubs open a number of opportunities and pathways for people who have aspirations to work within sport. You can start umpiring for pocket money or you can help in an official role and get an inside into sports management.

Maybe you are more attracted to numbers and figures and could assist the treasurer. Or maybe a budding journalism career could start writing the record notes.

Volunteers are so hard to come by and it is experience that could separate you from your peers. One of the best things you can do as a youth or an adult is join a board or committee. It's a great way to realise that games of netball don't just happen. There is so much work that goes into every decision at team level, club level and league level. By putting yourself in official roles at the club you will have a greater understanding and appreciation of what goes on behind the scenes.

Community sport provides a place for all ages to enjoy a common interest in a safe environment.

If nothing else just enjoy being on court and leave your poor behaviour at home.
