Woodend Hesket vs Wallan

Both clubs played in big matches last weekend and this is no step down.

Hawks got the job done against the Cats and look like serious contenders this season while the Magpies were not disgraced by flag favourites Diggers Rest.

Both teams will be eager to put their best foot forward this weekend and to take four valuable premiership points.

From the Coaches:

Woodend Hesket: We played really well on Saturday it is probably the most it has clicked for us all year which is a good sign. I am super proud of the group. It is a massive game this weekend I really rate them as a side and in particular some of their experienced midfielders such as Stevey Boyall and Corey Vianni. They always seem to get a hold of us. Unfortunately I won't be out there with the boys this week as I have strained my hamstring. The two weeks off after this should hopefully give me enough time to get myself right.

Wallan: It was our first loss of the season but we are still really positive. We learnt a lot from the game. Unfortunately, we lose Jacob Langbourne for a few weeks. Woodend is another big test. Especially at their ground. They have recruited well and have built a strong list over the last few seasons. Dan Toman and Martin are certainly players to keep an eye on but they have talent across the board.

Players to watch

Woodend Hesket: Dan Davie made his presence felt in the forward line last weekend and is on the verge of breaking a game open.

Wallan: Steve Boyall plays his best football against the Hawks. Have they worked out a way to stop him or will get plenty of the football again this weekend.

From the Coaches:

Players to watch

And young gun Jackson Wadden showed that he's going to be a really good senior footballer in his debut. We didn't capitalize on the scoreboard however we felt like we had plenty of inside 50s to steal the win in the fourth but full credit to Melton Centrals. They play their home ground well and brought a great contest all day. Looking to this weekend back at our home ground where we feel we have played some solid football this season will be a bit of a boost. 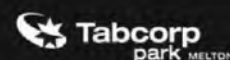

TACKLE YOUR FEELINGS



Essendon are partnering with the Tackle Your Feelings (TYF) program to make mental health training available to community coaches, in 2023. Tackle Your Feelings is a free mental health training program for community AFL coaches, as well as committee members and other club support staff. The program is delivered by a local psychologist and aims to help participants gain the tools to Understand, Recognise and Respond to signs of mental ill-health in their players. In 2021, the program was delivered to more than 4000 community coaches from 352 clubs across every Australian state and territory. 'Tackle your Feelings' was inspired by mental health education developed for AFL professional coaches and players, consisting of a face-to-face presentation from a local psychologist and additional online learning. Ambassadors include Leon Cameron, Alastair Clarkson, Nathan Buckley, Neville Jetta, Kara Antonio and Dylan Buckley also feature throughout

the video content within the program. The program was formed by the AFL Coaches Association, AFL Players' Association and Zurich Insurance in 2018, after the tragic death of Adelaide coach Phil Walsh three years earlier.

How your club can get involved

Tackle Your Feelings is a free program and is available to your club in 2023.

Once coaches complete the training (workshop and online modules) they will have access to resources including blogs, podcasts and videos to assist with their ongoing learning. Participating clubs are eligible for the Tackle Your Feelings rewards program, which includes footballs, equipment and access to program ambassadors.

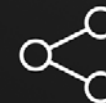
