A Message to our Players, Coaches, Spectators & Parents,

After an extremely difficult 2020 for so many, it is fantastic to have community sport return and it is wonderful to have all of our players, coaches, spectators, umpires and parents return to RDFNL venues for Junior and Senior football and netball.

Some Clubs have returned bigger and better than ever in 2021 after the year off, and some, have returned but struggled for players or volunteers to assist on and off the field. Like many of our Clubs, across community football in Victoria, we have seen a considerable drop off in umpire numbers due to a number of factors. The RDFNL is very fortunate to have the Riddell Umpires Association facilitate all Junior and Senior football matches each weekend. Unlike many other Leagues, the RDFNL has been able to field a full complement of umpires in 2021. That being said, some of the abhorrent abuse coming the way of umpires from players, coaches, parents, and spectators has been appalling and we as a League and all other community leagues are at a very important juncture. If this ridiculous behaviour continues, football matches will not have umpires and our Clubs will have to find volunteers to fill the void. The abuse of umpires needs to stop, immediately.

The League has also had an alarming number of incidents of extremely poor behaviour by coaches. We understand how passionate our coaches are and we are ever so thankful for those coaches who put their hand up to volunteer their time to coach a team, whether it be football or netball, at Senior or Junior level. It can be an all-consuming task and people are juggling that role with work and family life. However, just because you have put your hand up to take on the role, it does not give you the right to abuse the position of power that you have. Our coaches play a very crucial role as role models for their players. Each year we have a number of players walk away from the game they love because of a poor experience the year before and a lot of that can be attributed to their coach. 95% of the coaches we have in our competitions do a wonderful job and we appreciate the job that they do but the other 5% who are creating an unsuitable environment, please rethink your coaching philosophy and remember why you put your hand up to help in the first place.

Finally, to our parents and spectators who come to our matches each weekend, please remember that we are not the AFL, the players do not play for AFL teams and our umpires are not officiating in the AFL. Whilst it is great to have

some fun and some banter, if you are coming to hurl abuse or carry on inappropriately, find somewhere else to go.

Good luck to everyone for the remainder of the RDFNL season, we are two thirds of the way through the season and a wonderful Finals Series is awaiting us but let's get the behaviour back on track so everyone can enjoy their community sport.

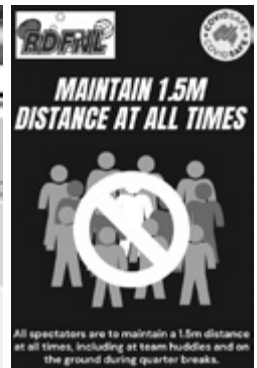
TAC Road Safety Round

Melton Centrals vs Western Rams

Talking Points

It is a big game for both clubs. Melton Centrals have recorded just one win this season and Western Rams are still trying to find their first victory. Its been a year of development for both clubs and there are plenty of positives that would be nicely rewarded with some success this weekend.

From the coaches

Melton Centrals: We did play better but lack of tall forwards is an issue for us and Romsey tall forwards are a handful

Our goals are to keep playing younger players to develop them by getting senior games into them, qualify our reserves in the finals so some of those players can also get some finals experience.

We will still be trying to win some games, but it will be hard if we don't have our full complement of players. The positives for me are how our players are still buying in despite the results and the vibe around the club has been positive and a great place to be, which goes well for the future

Western Rams: It certainly was a break we probably didn't need. The last time we had a break from covid, we lost some momentum, fingers crossed, we don't have the same outcome.

I think we match up well against Centrals this weekend as opposed to Round 1. We have continued to work hard and gel together every week so we are in a much better position with the team and understanding one another now than we were back then.

Our last few games we have started really well so if we can do the same with that this week, we will look to continue the pressure through the 4 quarters.

One thing we are confident about is what we set out to achieve from day 1 and that's our culture. Centrals are a quality outfit. Fingers crossed for a competitive game and may the best team win.

Who to watch?

Melton Centrals: Spry, Culhane, Apineru, Foley and Johns, are players Western Rams will pay particular attention to.

Western Rams: Josh Casey has been a solid leader for Western Rams all season long and with some of

the better players missing he will need to stand up again this weekend.

Prediction: Melton Centrals to record a second win in a closely contested game.

Woodend Heskett vs Diggers Rest

Talking Points: It feels like a long time ago that these teams met in Round 1. Diggers Rest have had their ups and downs as have Woodend Heskett but a win here will go a long way for both teams. Diggers Rest will go into the game as favourites. They got through last weeks game injury free and Woodend Heskett were quite the opposite. Last time they met at Gilbert Gordon it was Woodend Heskett who took the points and the boys at Diggers Rest haven't forgotten about it.

From the coaches

Woodend Heskett: We were really disappointed with our efforts on Saturday and put in a really tired performance after a couple of competitive weeks, but Macedon were incredible. It was as good a display as I've seen from any team in my time in the league.

It will be really interesting to see how we can respond against another strong team bound for finals and it's a part of our learning curve. We are battling a very long injury list at the moment but we have to find a way to play consistently despite that.

With Patak, French, Pound and Laverie missing from our midfield the past few weeks we have been really vulnerable in that area and Macedon exposed that on the weekend leading to a big differential in inside 50's. It's an area we need a big improvement from.

Alexander (calf), Wilson (hamstring), Duff Tytler (eye nerve) were added to injury list from the weekend. We will potentially have 7 to 8 players out of our best 22.

Diggers Rest: We are going okay. We are really happy with how our young kids are going and our older brigade are still contributing. The young fellas just go through under the radar. This week is just another week for us. We are back in some form and where we want to be but we still need to keep winning games. We are not worried about Woodend Heskett and that's not being arrogant that just us knowing what we need to do and who we need to focus on. If we can put some score board pressure on them early we think that will give us the best

opportunity. They are a very hard team to catch once they get a lead.

Who to watch?

Woodend Hasket: Tayte Pears is a well-known name and it appears all the coaches in the league are keeping a close eye on him.

Diggers Rest: Last time they met the Hawks has trouble getting through their half back line of Hine, Krul and Tyquin.

Prediction: Diggers Rest to record another strong win.

Riddell vs Wallan

Talking Points

It is a big game for the Bombers. They have been in and out of form and in recent weeks they have cashed in on a few credits they had in the bank with losses against Diggers Rest and Wallan. Both teams will play finals but where they finish will rely on winning matches like this. Following a seriously courageous act last week Riddell's Riley Paterson's season was cut short. The league and his club Riddell wish him all the best with his recovery in the coming weeks and months.

From the coaches

Riddell: Last time we thought we had our match ups right but it wasn't there where we fell down it was the next five or six players that did the damage. We just really hope we can put in a better showing this time around. We were disappointed in the result last time we met. On the weekend it was a really good game and the result could have gone either way. Losing Riley was big for us and we hope he is on the mend but he is going to be sore for a while yet.

Wallan: I'm just praying Covid doesn't cross the NSW / Vic boarder. Full credit to Lancefield who tested us early and played well in the first half. The players responded well after the main break and got the game on our terms. It was pleasing to finish the game strong and our fitness to run out the game was evident. When our boys click like that, they are exciting to watch but we need a four quarter effort the next few weeks. Our backline were suburb again. Riddell are always tough to beat at home but hopefully our group can execute the game plan, in what looks like wet conditions

Who to watch?

Riddell: Croft is a star of the competition and will need to be watched closely

Wallan: Corey Grindlay has X Factor qualities and after kicking nine last weekend he will have plenty of eyes on him this week.

Prediction: Wallan to record a comfortable win.

Lancefield vs Romsey

Talking Points

Romsey are still fighting for a final berth in 2021 but a loss here would make it difficult. Lancefield on the other hand have different goals in place but have been playing good football and will be looking for an improved score line from last time they met. An upset could definitely be on the cards.

From the coaches

Lancefield: Wallan are a very good team. We were able to match them for a half but then they stepped it up a notch and we couldn't go with them.

We have been a lot more competitive over the last few weeks so go in very confident this week. Last time we played them we were only competitive for three quarters and that was the difference. We know nothing less than a 4 quarter effort will get the job done.

We've got to keep the pressure on them all day. They like to get it on the outside and run so we have to win the contested ball, keep it in tight and not let them get it to their outside players.

Blair's been in great form this year so definitely one to watch. Jedwab up forward kicked a bag against us last time and is right up there fighting with Perri for the goal kicking so we need to limit the ball in his hands.

Romsey: It is really important for Romsey to get a win here and set themselves up for a tough run home.

Who to watch?

Lancefield: Alex Ryan made his debut last week and impressed.

Romsey: Burkett in the middle is a genuine gun so we need to watch him.

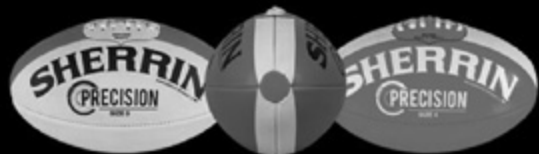

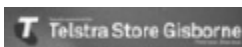

Other than the Player bringing the football into play, all Players must make every endeavour to immediately vacate the Protected Area described in Diagram 3.

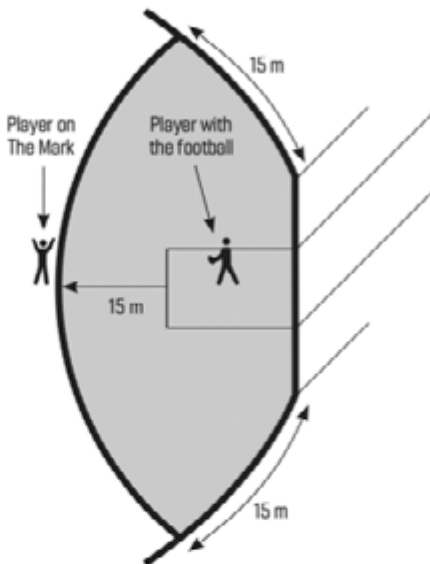

17.4 ATTACKING TEAM DELAYING RECOMMENCEMENT OF PLAY

Where the field Umpire is of the opinion that a Player from the Attacking Team:

- is within the Protected Area described in Law 17.3 at the time when a Player from the Defending Team is bringing the football back into play, and not made every endeavour to immediately vacate the area;
- has prevented or attempted to prevent the Player from the Defending Team from bringing the football back into play; or
- has otherwise delayed play.

The field Umpire shall award a Free Kick to the Defending Team and a Fifty Metre Penalty from The Mark.

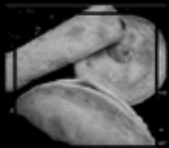
