Updated RDFNL Season Structure

Wasn't it great to have the football and netball back last weekend after missing two weeks and also the Queen's Birthday long weekend? Because the season lost the weekend of May 29th and June 5th, some changes had to be made to the season structure. Please note that Rounds 7 and 8 were rescheduled for the weekends of June 19th and 26th with Round 9 now to be played on July 3rd and so on.

The re-scheduling of Rounds 7 and 8 means that the League can still have an 18 Round home and away season as planned with each Club playing 16 matches, 8 at home and 8 away and playing each opponent on two occasions.

Because two weekends were lost and no home and away matches lost, we had to make up two weeks of the season. The RDFNL has decided to push back the GF weekend by one weekend and also reduce the Finals Series from a top 5 over 4 weekends to a top 4 over three weekends. The RDFNL GF will now be played the same weekend as the AFL GF. The League will decide in the coming weeks whether the RDFNL GF will be played on the Public Holiday on Friday, September 24th or on Sunday, September 26th.

The AFL has introduced new Concussion Guidelines for community football to further align with the Concussion Policy at the elite level. The AFL is taking concussion extremely seriously and we encourage all Clubs and relevant Club trainers to access the Guidelines and implement them at Club level to ensure any player who suffers a concussion is cared for appropriately and does not return to training or matches until it is safe to do so.

AFL Victoria Strategic Community Investment Fund

Round 2 applications for the AFL Victoria Strategic Community Investment Fund (SCIF) for 2021 are now open. The SCIF will provide grant funding of \$1.5 million per year for the next three years directly to local football Leagues and Clubs. The fund is part of the \$18 million investment into Victorian Community Football announced by the AFL in September 2019, the largest investment in community football in the state in more than two decades.










2021 NEW LAWS OF THE GAME

17.3 PROTECTED AREA

Other than the Player bringing the football into play, all Players must make every endeavour to immediately vacate the Protected Area described in Diagram 3.



17.4 ATTACKING TEAM DELAYING RECOMMENCEMENT OF PLAY

Where the field Umpire is of the opinion that a Player from the Attacking Team:

- (a) is within the Protected Area described in Law 17.3 at the time when a Player from the Defending Team is bringing the football back into play, and not made every endeavour to immediately vacate the area;
- (b) has prevented or attempted to prevent the Player from the Defending Team from bringing the football back into play; or
- (c) has otherwise delayed play.

The field Umpire shall award a Free Kick to the Defending Team and a Fifty Metre Penalty from The Mark.



WESTERN WATER NETBALL REPORT by RDFNL Netball Manager Grace Bibby

It was great to be back playing netball on the weekend after a month of uncertainty while the majority of the state battled Covid 19 restrictions.

With round seven out of the way it is important to start making sure we are doing everything possible to make sure we are adhering to the by laws and preparing for finals.

Some areas of concern are always player qualifications.

It is also a timely reminder that no one can play any recognized Netball Victoria competition without registering with a VNA membership.

The league have been lenient with this to begin the season however fines and penalties will start to apply moving forward.

This is for the benefit of the individual should any injuries occur.

If you are unsure whether you have qualified for finals or have over qualified in a particular grade please refer to the by laws below.

By law 16 - Player Qualification - Seniors

(a) All other eligibility criteria and player registration rules and by-laws must be followed.

(b) Players may play a maximum of 2 matches per round, during the home and away season with their club in any grade, subject to part (e).

(c) A player who has played more than one match in a round in a day shall only have their higher match recorded as match played when determining finals eligibility. The second match will not count when determining finals eligibility. A 19 & Under player will have the underage & the senior grade match recorded as qualification matches for both age group/grade. (d) Any team may list up to 12 players in any one match, and there will be no limit on the number of substitutions made.

(e) Any player who has played six (6) matches in a higher grade, cannot play in a lower grade for the remainder of the season (except 19 & Under players refer to 16(c)).

If a player is found to have played a game in lower grade after they have already played 6 games in higher grade they will lose premiership points for that round and the club will be fined \$100.00.

(f) Players must take the court in the match for it to be counted as a qualifying game. Players who remain on the interchange bench shall not have the match recorded as a qualifying game.

(g) Players in all grades must play at least four (4) matches in that season in one grade/age group to be eligible to participate in that grade's final series.

(h) A player can only play in one (1) finals match on the same weekend except for players in the 19 & Under competition who can play in two (2) matches maximum on the same weekend, as long as they have met the qualification requirements as stated in 16 (g).

Please also note if you are looking to bring in players all clearances must be complete before round 9 commences.

All RDFNL staff and board members are looking forward to the second half of the season and we hope there is less disruptions than in the first half.

If you have any questions regarding age criteria, player qualifications or clearances for players please contact the league via your netball coordinator.

We do not want to have to have these tough conversations in the lead up to finals.





AFL Victoria will continue to work closely with the Victorian Government and advocate on behalf of the game for what we hope will be a further easing of restrictions. More information will be provided to leagues and clubs as soon as it is made available by the government.
