## Riddell to join 72,000 players in the Pat Cronin Foundation Round's stand against violence

Riddell District Football Netball League will take part in its first Pat Cronin Foundation Round – a bumper 72,000 player event this year - honouring the memory of a Melbourne teenager who lost his life to a Coward Punch.

Riddell will join six other leagues in the 3038-team event, spanning 120 venues from Melbourne to Bendigo. A highlight will be the local marquee match between Kyneton and the Riddell Bombers, set to draw a strong crowd at Kyneton Showgrounds on Saturday, May 3.

Every player will wear a yellow armband – the official colour of the Foundation – to symbolise a stand against all forms of violence, including the Coward Punch.

The Foundation, which provides specialised violence-prevention education to more than 80,000 young Australians in sports clubs and schools each year, was formed after the death of promising young footballer Pat Cronin.

Pat never came home after what was supposed to be a quiet night with mates in Melbourne on April 16, 2016, after playing his first senior game with game earlier in the day with his older brother.

RDFNL Chief Executive Jordan Doyle said the league was proud to be part of such a meaningful initiative.

“As a responsible sporting organisation, we are committed to educating our

players not just on the game but on life,” he said. “Helping young people understand the consequences of violence and giving them tools to manage their emotions – especially under pressure – is vital.”

Foundation director Matt Cronin, the father of Pat, said the Round was a powerful way to connect with young people at a grassroots level.

“The growth we’ve seen in just three seasons has been remarkable,” he said. “The addition of leagues like Riddell has pushed player participation to over 72,000 – a sign that people truly want to be part of the change.

“We believe in the power of simple, visible acts – like the yellow armband or pre- and post-match handshakes – because they spark real conversations. They’re reminders that violence is never the answer, and walking away is always the stronger choice.”

Other leagues in the Round are: Yarra Junior Football League, Essendon District Football League, Eastern Football Netball League, Western Football Netball League, Northern Football Netball League and Bendigo Football Netball League.

Looking ahead, Mr Cronin hopes to extend the event, reaching into other leagues and sports across Victoria.
