# ACROSS MY DESK

The Importance of Physical, Social, and Emotional Development in Sport  
 Sport is a unique and powerful platform that supports not only physical health but also social connection and emotional maturity. When approached with the right values and support, it can help shape well-rounded, resilient, and capable individuals.

## 1. Physical Development

Sport enhances overall fitness, including strength, flexibility, endurance, and motor skills. For young people, it supports critical stages of physical growth and helps build:

- Muscular and skeletal strength, reducing injury risk and promoting long-term health.
- Gross and fine motor coordination, which contributes to physical confidence and the ability to learn new skills.
- Healthy lifestyle habits, including better sleep, nutrition awareness, and routine exercise.
- Reduced health risks, such as obesity, diabetes, and cardiovascular issues later in life.

Importantly, regular participation in sport can encourage a lifelong relationship with physical activity, which is key to maintaining health across the lifespan.

## 2. Social Development

Sport is deeply social. Whether in team or individual settings, athletes interact, build relationships, and develop social awareness. Key benefits include:

- Teamwork and cooperation, learning to share success, support others, and achieve group goals.
- Communication skills, both verbal and non-verbal, as athletes give

S instructions, encourage teammates, and respond to challenges.

- Respect and sportsmanship, as players learn to follow rules, accept decisions, and value opponents.
- Leadership and responsibility, with many athletes stepping into roles that require guiding others and modeling positive behavior.

These experiences help athletes build empathy, resilience in group settings, and the ability to function in diverse teams – crucial life and workplace skills.

## 3. Emotional Development

Emotionally, sport provides a rich environment for growth. It teaches individuals to understand, manage, and express emotions in constructive ways.

Benefits include:

- Resilience, as athletes cope with setbacks, injuries, and losses, learning to persevere and bounce back.
- Self-confidence and self-esteem, built through skill mastery, personal achievement, and positive reinforcement.
- Stress and emotion regulation, as sports teach how to stay calm under pressure, manage frustration, and remain focused.

Participation in sport has also been shown to reduce symptoms of anxiety and depression, contributing to better mental health outcomes.

Sport offers far more than just physical exercise. It is a dynamic space for developing physical skills, building meaningful social connections, and fostering emotional resilience.

# NETBALL MANAERS REPORT

## by General Manager Operations Grace Bibby

Do you have some athletes that may not get large amounts of court time as we enter the pointy end of the season.

Maybe you're a coach of a junior competition or your kids are involved in sports and you coach them at home.

Here are some tips to inspire young athletes to give their best and not grow discouraged with defeat or setbacks.

**Coaching Tip # 1:** Motivate through specific clear short-term goals. Large or general goals can be overwhelming, so try breaking a practice into fun, manageable goals that don't overwhelm the players.

**Coaching Tip # 2:** Reward attitude as much as skills. During practice, often give players goals that don't have to do with the game of basketball. For example, ask your players to give a certain number of encouragements or compliments to team members. Or challenge the team to see who can give the most high-fives in an hour. This is part of the effort to keep the team interested and enthusiastic about the opportunity to participate on an organised team and to create an understanding between winning and success. Success isn't always about winning the game but how you treat your teammates and handle yourself on the court.

**Coaching Tip # 3:** Manage expectations. A player can have a self-expectation, team expectations, family expectations, coach expectations, and analytical (statistical) expectations that all influence a player's performance and demeanour. If an athlete has high expectations towards challenges, it is human nature for the athlete to do whatever it takes and give a dedicated

effort in meeting and exceeding that expectation. Problem is, some players have too high expectations and feel pressured, while others have the opposite issue – too low of expectations. Apathy can become a hindering habit.

To handle players with too-high expectations, try emphasize the fun of the sport and the mindset of "just playing," as this takes away the pressure.

**Coaching Tip # 4:** Be careful with criticism. For a coach to establish an effective environment it is key to build genuine relationships among team and praise athletes for doing well as much as possible. One way to create a positive atmosphere even when we must give criticism is by using the "positive sandwich" method. Try starting by giving praise, then give the correction/advice and end the point of instruction with positive feedback for constructive criticism.

**Coaching Tip # 5:** Emphasize the value of every player. One individual may score a goal, but we help the players understand every goal is actually a team effort. Break down a play to praise and acknowledge the small details that are just as important in getting that goal. Also stress that in netball there are different roles. Someone has to shoot, someone has to pass, someone has to rebound and someone has to defend. However, one common role everyone on the team has is to recognize the value of each role and be a supportive teammate. The value of teamwork can never be stressed enough. Some great takeaways for aspiring coaches at your club.
