

RDFNL Senior Mens Previews

In a highly anticipated Round 8 match-up Macedon faces off against Woodend-Hesket in a game that holds plenty of significance for both clubs.

Both sides enter the fixture hungry for ladder points, with Macedon eyeing a move further into finals contention and Woodend-Hesket looking to build momentum.

Macedon, known for its structured ball movement and hard-nosed midfield unit, will look to gain control early through clean clearances and precision forward entries. Star players such as skipper Hamish Govan and star forward Jason Cooke will be pivotal if the Cats are to stamp their authority on the game.

On the other side, Woodend-Hesket come into this one with their best game for a number of years as they dismantled Lancefield last weekend.

As the game progresses, Macedon's ball use by foot and spread from stoppages should allow them to find more open space and forward options. However, Woodend-Hesket continues to stay in the hunt, and get first use through Marcus Stapleton who has been in outstanding form they will back themselves in late.

The result of this match could have a real impact on the makeup of the top six. For Macedon and Woodend-Hesket, a victory here will close the gap on the current top six.

Prediction: Macedon to win in a close one.

On their most recent meeting during Round 4 of the 2024 season, Wallan delivered a commanding performance, defeating Melton Centrals 160 to 35. The game saw Wallan's offensive prowess shine, with their forwards capitalizing on opportunities. Melton Centrals struggled to contain the onslaught, managing only five goals throughout the match.

Wallan will have to do some soul searching after a disappointing loss at the hands of league newcomer Melton South last week. Melton Centrals also let a winnable game go begging as they led at three quarter time and feel short to Romsey.

The outcome of this match is likely to hinge on the midfield contest. Melton Centrals will need to disrupt Wallan's ball movement and gain control of the centre clearances to prevent their forwards from getting on top. Wallan's midfield depth and ability to transition quickly will be crucial in maintaining their dominance. While Melton Centrals have shown signs of improvement, Wallan's consistent form and recent victories position them as favourites for this matchup. However, if Melton Centrals can replicate their recent competitive performances and execute a disciplined game plan, they have the potential to challenge Wallan.

This encounter will be a test of Melton Centrals' resilience and growth, while Wallan will aim to continue their dominant run.

Prediction: Wallan to take the four points.
