FINALS WEEK 2 RDFNL PREVIEWS with Grace Bibby





Riddell vs Wallan

The first opportunity to book their spot in the grand final will be up for grabs today and it is the tale of two different stories. Riddell are the minor premiers coming into this one fresh off the bye while Wallan came from behind for a hard-fought win over Diggers Rest. Two years goo these teams found themselves in this exact position. Will Riddell win their way through to another grand final or will Daniel Nolan and his men finally make it to the big one? If Riddell win it will be the first senior grand final for their coach Arron Bray who has fallen short more times than you can count on one hand.

From the Coaches

Riddell: We are really happy with where we are at. We watched all the teams sloa it out last weekend and we got a good session into the leas on Saturday. Wallan have every right to be up and about it was a really good win over Diggers Rest. We still think if we worry about us and play to our strengths we are going to be in a good position. If we play attacking and just adjust to what they do well during the game we think we will be in good shape. It is going to be a really good contest. It has been close both times this season and they will be wanting to aet us. We want it as much as anyone. Avoiding a preliminary final is the best way forward we believe. Chirs Stewart obviously can just flick a switch and go into beast mode but he can only play in one position. We think Josh Grabham will match up on him in the middle and then Ben Sonogon will get the job probably in the second half when he ages forward. There is no doubt he is a fantastic player and a tough match up but we think our forwards are also pretty good

and their back six might be where they are most vulnerable.

Wallan: It was another epic finals battle. We have had some fantastic contests over the past few years with Diggers. To their credit, they were huge in the second quarter the half time break was so important to pause, reflect and make a few changes. To the boys credit, they adapted and worked their way back into the contest. We obviously don't want to be 28 points down again but it does give the group some belief, to never give up and keep fighting. Some pleasing performances were from Chris Stewart, Brodie & Rilev Gilchrist, Reuben Rode, Pat Mahonev and Jake Carlisle. Stevie Bovall continues to impress with his return too. We were also down two rotations in the second half with unfortunate injuries to Fowler and Mackertich. This Saturday will be a huae test, as we play Riddell who finished on top and deserve favouritism. They have had the extra break but our boys have some strong momentum and believe anything is possible. We are playing an exciting brand at the moment and hopefully it can hold up again on Saturday.

Players to watch

Riddell: Dylan Tarczon is a bull that can kick aoals and his size and skill in the forward line will be a tough match up for Wallan.

Wallan: Chris Stewart was a match winner with just nine possessions last week. Can he be as damaging this week?

Prediction: Riddell to book their spot in the 2024 Bendigo Bank RDFNL Senior Grand Final.

Interesting that these four teams played in the exact matches two years ago following the same matches in week 1 of the same finals series.

From the Coaches

Diagers Rest: We did a lot right against Wallan on the weekend. We played some really good football but you just cant afford to have a lapse or take your foot off the pedal. We left the door open and let them back in and then couldn't stop the momentum. Hopefully we have learned from that and we can be better across the four auarter this weekend. Macedon are plavina some really acod football and AI has them playing well so it will be a good contest. We still strongly believe our best football is good enough. A lot of this group have been in this position before and we were able to turn it around. We will get a few players back this week in defence which should sure us up a little bit. The stakes are pretty high now hopefully we can play our best football and get a win. It is always a worry coming up against a young team who are fearless.

Macedon: I love coaching this group. They adapted so well to what we asked. Like everyone we knew that weather was coming and we knew what the rules were. We wanted to get a good start. We changed a fair bit of our normal structure and the trust the group have was just remarkable. They listened and just went to work.

We have so many young kids playing their first senior final and then we have some players who haven't won one in six years. The young kids played well but so did the older guys it was just a fantastic win. We have to back ourselves in to keep riding the wave but if you look at the stats Diggers Rest were pretty good on the weekend. It is going to be a really tough game but we hope we are up to the challenge. We have hung tough in some close games and been on the wrong end. We have been in all but one game this season at three guarter time. If we do that again we will have our chances. We know finals go up another level and the boys certainly felt that last weekend and hope we can rise again this weekend. It will be a big occasion and to add to the day we will celebrate an icon of our club Nippa playing his 250th senior Macedon game. He is arguably the most decorated Cat to have ever played and to celebrate his milestone with a win in the second week of finals over Diggers Rest would be something pretty surreal.

Players to watch

Diggers Rest: Jaidyn Caruana got plenty of the ball and was one of the Diggers Rest best in their loss in week 1 of the finals.

Macedon: Xavier Moraan was the player of the week in the first week of finals with his five score involvements.

Prediction: Diggers Rest to end Macedon's season after a gallant fight from the Cats.



ROMSEY DENTAL NETBALL REPORT by RDFNL Netball Manager Grace Bibby

Finals make for some interesting lessons on leadership and performance, and these apply equally to business and life overall.

Last week, I had the chance to observe first hand the dynamics of winning and losing at the RDFNL Senior Finals. Whereas the early rounds of competition were about separating out the more talented teams from the less, the later rounds were all about the differences in their ability to perform under pressure. That's where it got really interesting. As we watched equally talented teams either wilt under the pressure or rise to the occasion, the word that kept cropping up from the players themselves to the coaches and also my fellow spectators was: composure. This seemed to encapsulate the difference between winning and losing at the top level of the competition and even more so on Sunday for our Elimination Finals.

So how do we define composure? The dictionary says it is a "serene, self-controlled state of mind; calmness; tranquillity." In the context of finals level competition, it means the ability to keep a cool head and perform to your full potential under pressure; it's about being able to make and execute on the same decisions in the same way when under pressure as when there is no pressure at all.

We saw teams get frazzled and fall apart as the competition got tougher ("they didn't keep their composure") whereas they had played as a well-oiled unit earlier in the season. We watched individual players work hard to get the ball up the court and finally break free but the goalers weren't able to convert and we saw defenders create turn overs and then give it straight back while others seemed to revel in the intensity of the moment and make heroic shots and come up with intercepts against all odds.

Imagine what we could achieve if each of us could be so much in our element when the going gets tough — if our environment could have no adverse effect on our performance at that crucial client meeting or when speaking in front of hundreds of our peers.

So how do we improve our composure? How can we sustain peak performance under increasing pressure? Part of this ability is intrinsic, and some people are simply born with it. But fortunately for the rest of us, much of it can be acquired through self-awareness, experience and training.

1. Stay Passionate but Don't Allow Your Emotions to Get in the Way

Seasoned leaders know that passion is everything and burying their emotions is futile. But that doesn't mean we can wear our emotions on our sleeves, especially when cooler heads must prevail. Don't yell or get overly animated when times get tough. Keep positive body language.

2. Keep a Positive Mental Attitude

Opposition are always watching their leader's actions, behaviour, relationships and overall demeanour. During the most difficult of times, leaders must maintain a positive mental attitude and manage a narrative that keeps their teammates inspired and hopeful. This is where your leadership experience and resolve can really shine – by staying strong, smiling often and authentically exhibiting a sense of compassion. Leaders set the tone for the team and club they serve. A positive attitude can neutralize chaos and allow a leader to course correct through any negativity even if the game is not going their way.

3. Remain Courageous

During uncertain times, leaders must remain fearless. I've been through ups and downs in my career and have learned that when you begin to fear adverse circumstances, you not only put yourself in a position of vulnerability, but it becomes extremely difficult to act rationally and focus. When you panic, you mentally freeze. If you begin to get fearful, ask yourself: What is the worst possible thing that can happen? When you have the will and confidence to face that, you will realize that the situation is manageable and can be resolved. If you are a shooting don't stop shooting the ball because you are worried it will miss.

4. Take Accountability

Leaders should be most composed during times of crisis and change and be fully committed to resolving the issue at hand. When they are accountable, this means that they have made the decision to assume responsibility and take the required steps to problem solve before the situation aets out of hand. When leaders assume accountability, they begin to neutralize the problem and place the environment from which it sprung on pause. It's easy to lose composure during finals especially if you let concern turn into worry and worry turn into fear. By maintaining composure, the best leaders remain calm, cool and in control - enabling them to step back, critically evaluate the cards that they have been dealt and face problems head-on. A show of composure also puts those vou lead at ease and creates a safe and secure culture where no one needs to panic when the heat is on. We are looking forward to being on the sidelines again this weekend to see which teams and individuals will stand up under pressure.




