Preliminary Final - Wallan vs Macedon

Wallan have made it to their third consecutive preliminary final while the young fearless Cats are there for the first time in many years. The Cats will go into this one with nothing to lose and the underdog but will Wallan be able to perform with all the pressure on them? In their previous two encounters this season Wallan have taken the four points. Previous results will fill the Wallan camp with confidence but current form would have the same result for Macedon. This should be a fantastic contest between two fantastic teams.

From the Coaches

Wallan: The conditions were challenging on Saturday and Riddell adapted late to get the victory. Well done to Skip and his playing group.

Now we focus on Macedon, who are young and playing an attractive brand of football. Al Meldrum is a terrific coach and they finished strong against Diggers last week. Cooke was outstanding and leads them well up forward. I have faith in our playing group and leaders to respond. Jake Carlisle has been influential recently and so has Steven Boyall. Pat Mahoney has hit some excellent form too and can play at both ends of the ground. We have fallen short the previous 2 years in Preliminary Finals, so hopefully we can produce a good team performance on Saturday. It's a beautiful ground Kyneton and should be a great spectacle. Our Reserves are also playing, which is wonderful for the depth of the club.

Macedon: Coaching this group is something else. They have so much belief they listen they work hard and they work for each other. The players had to make changes to how we played the first half and they are so adaptable. We took the pace off the


game and we controlled the football, we were able to take a lot more uncontested marks in the second half and get the ball into our forwards. There is a lot of confidence in the group and the feeling on Sunday was second to only the 2017 premiership win and we just want to keep feeling that. That is what is driving the boys the general enjoyment we are getting from playing football. All season we were there abouts without getting results and I think one area we needed to work on was contested ball and we have improved in finals in that area. That is probably the difference. Wallan are the best team in the comp in that area. We will be missing some players and they will be as well. Everyone is sore and has niggling injuries this time of year but the team that turns up on the day probably get the reward. We don't think we are just making up numbers we are really looking forward to a great contest on a big open ground with plenty of support. The extra feedback over the fence, the noise, the intensity this group thrives on all of it and we are excited to get out there.

Wallan: Stevie Boyall was the player of the week last weekend letting everyone know his Bowen medal form from a couple of years ago isn't far away as he continues to come back from his knee injury.

Macedon: Jason Cooke had one of the best halves of football you will see last weekend kicking seven and bringing the Cats back from the brink of a season ending loss.

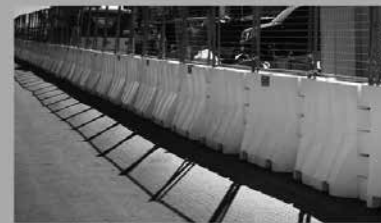

ROMSEY DENTAL NETBALL REPORT

With just one week to go now until the big one it is a good time to reflect on what has been another fantastic season on and off court.

While our competition continues to grow the standard is always improving and the impact our clubs and teams are having on their small communities is second to none.

Sport is a key part of everyone who is involved for very different reasons.

Is it your social outing for the week, is it your second family full of support or do you turn up for an hour of physical activity each week.

Here are some of the key factors of why people stay involved in sport.

Top motivations to participate in sport physical activity by Australian aged 15+ living in regional or remote areas.

- physical health or fitness
- fun/enjoyment
- social reasons
- psychology/mental health/therapy
- to be outdoors/to enjoy nature
- to lose weight/keep weight off/tone
- physical therapy/rehab/post op
- hobby
- performance or competition
- for training purposes

While money is sometimes a factor the best way to bring players to a club and retain them is often the cheapest... Culture.

Create an environment where your club actively promotes, encourages and recognises volunteers and the role they play in making your organisation successful.

Putting time into creating an environment where everyone feels welcome and safe will help volunteers feel part of your community. Look at ways you can understand and connect with your members and wider community to create a place that is inclusive and reflective of their needs.

What does a thriving team and club culture look like?

A healthy culture is one that actively promotes positive attitudes, values, and beliefs. Members of a club, league, organisation or association that work hard toward a shared goal while appreciating each other's differences and contributions. A winning, healthy culture also means that they respect

opposing team members and umpires. Coaches treat team members with respect while holding them to a high standard of professional conduct, letting them know when they need to improve their performance in order to increase the odds of winning games. Coaches are free to hire and fire players and decide on strategies without unwarranted intervention from sponsors or committee members. All roles, responsibilities and boundaries are very clear.

The president and committee members take charge of ensuring the coach and their team are performing in accordance with the team's core values and expectations. These people choose their sponsors with care, ensuring any would-be sponsors reflect the team's values.

A diverse committee is ideal. A team composed of former participants or athletes, lawyers, accountants, and other experts that have the skills and real-world experience needed to manage and steer a club in the right direction. Ideally, a committee would include men and women from various ethnic backgrounds. Any committee should have a good capacity for balance. This can be quite hard because they can get pushed and pulled from side to side with competing goals. While the coach might say the focus is about getting results on the field, the treasurer will be looking at the books and seeking to manage funds more effectively while someone else is looking to spend money to create community connections to keep the flow of new members coming to the club. There needs to be a balance between interests - sporting outcomes, commercial interests and alignment with club culture goals.

Some things to consider when building club culture:

- Is your club reflective of the local community?
- Does your club offer family friendly activities and events?
- Consider what food and beverage options are available
- Does your club ask for feedback and input?
- Consider how your club welcomes new families, players and volunteers
- Consider how accessible your facilities and programs are
- Do committee members know their role?

Good clubs, often become great teams due to their club culture.

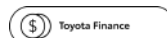
