Diggers Rest vs Macedon

This is a big occasion for these two clubs. Having met on Anzac Day at the beginning of the season and both shown patches of good form and form they would be less pleased with.

Fresh off the bye Macedon will be fit and ready to go but Diggers Rest were a long way off full strength last week. Will they get players back as they look to record a win on their home deck.

From the Coaches:

Diggers Rest: The guys played really well with several key players out which is great signs for the club with depth especially in the reserves. Generally when there is healthy competition everyone thrives. Moving onto this week it is a huge game, Macedon are playing some really good footy of late and coming off the bye they will be ready to go. We'll have to be at our best to get a win. A couple of their senior players are in good touch Cooke more dangerous than ever and will require some attention and Smedley back to some of his best prior to his injury. There is no such thing as four easy points in the league anymore.

Macedon: It is always a test to start well after the bye and you see that at all levels even at the elite. We started poorly against Diggers Rest on Anzac Day and you can't afford to give good teams that head start. We challenged late but we were coming from too far back. We had a good win over Centrals and our start was what set us up. We could then manage the game and play it to our liking. We are hopeful of a similar start this weekend. It is a lot easier to play chess when you have the board set up to your liking. They have some very impressive players who are very professional with how they go about it and we just have to try and minimize the damage they do. The club is in a really good spot right now our women are on top and have beaten everyone in the league now and our 19s got over Giants. We are really happy with how we are tracking and in the second half of this season we want to take a win or two off those above us in the seniors.

Players to watch

Diggers Rest: Sean Campbell dominated against the Cats early in the season and his fitness is a class above. Cats will need plenty to go their way to keep him away from the contest.

Macedon: Jason Cooke was in ominous form in his last outing and will be looking for another bag this weekend.

Prediction: Diggers Rest to win in another close game between these two teams.

Kyneton vs Riddell

Can Kyneton make a late charge? Many had written the Tigers off with their long list of injuries but some mid season recruiting has given the Tigers some life. This will be a tough game in front of a passionate Kyneton home crowd.

From the Coaches:

Kyneton: We are so happy with our performance on the weekend. We thought we matches up pretty well against Romsey and we know we like wide open grounds where we can put some pace on the ball and use our leg speed. We thought we did that really well. Having another one or two strong bodies in the midfield is really helping us get our hands on the football and that is pleasing. It feels like the game plan I starting to come together and a group we are finally getting it. We have plenty of work to do but that was a solid four quarter performance from us. Riddell in my eyes are the team to beat and we know we have to be at our best so hopefully we get a couple early and put our last game against Riddell behind us. Our crowd are amazing and we hope they can get behind us this weekend.

Riddell: We played really well. They came at us late but we had done enough to put them away which was pleasing. They are a good side. It was an arm wrestle in the early stages and the battle in the ruck was fantastic. Stewart and Grabham have to be the two best if not close to it. Stewart got on top of the hit outs but Grabham is so mobile he is like another mid it was just awesome to watch. Coming up against Kyneton we certainly respect them and after knocking off Romsey we will be treating them like any of the premiers contenders. Its going to be a fight to get the points. We are content with how we are travelling. We have good depth and people earning their spot. Lancefield vs Woodend Heskett

From the Coaches:

Lancefield: It is always disappointing to have your chances and not get a win. The reality is we are now 0-9 and we are running out of realistic chances to take the four points. We are confident we have the group who can compete but we just cant seem to pull four quarters together last week against Melton Centrals the game was scrappy and mostly played between the 50s a bit like tennis. We just lost our forward structure in the last couple of minutes when it was really important. We have some changes to make as a coaching group and the players have some changes to make onfoeld. We don't think a win is out of reach if we can all pull it together. Our worst result of the year came against Woodend Heskett so we want to erase that with a more competitive performance.

Woodend Heskett: It was disappointing. We had a good first quarter and then our second quarter was horrible. I was mainly disappointed as a lot of it was from effort. Second half was even but too much work to after half time.

We still struggled to capitalize on our forward entries. That's a still a big focus for us. We got a win against Lancefield last time so hopefully it is a good game and we can come out on top.

Players to watch

Lancefield: Riley O'Meara will have to shoulder even more of the workload with Zach Webb unavailable for the rest of the season and Lukas Fellows sidelined with an achilles injury.

Woodend Heskett: Daniel Toman racked up yet another performance of the week for his two goals and leather poisoning in their loss at the hands of Diggers Rest.

Prediction: Woodend Heskett to add to their win tally and Lancefield to remain winless.

Romsey vs Wallan

When we talk about big games and eight-point swings this is one of them. Both teams lost on the weekend and will be eager to bounce back. There is not much separating these two teams and last time they met each team dominated for a half but it was Romsey who took the points. This is going to be a close one.

From the Coaches:

Romsey: Kyneton were really good they came to play and as I keep saying you just can't afford an off game. We had our chances but we left the door slightly ajar and they were good enough to take the advantage. I am really proud of our group we continue to fight games out. You can only be as good as your opposition allow to you be and we have dropped two games at home. We want to make Romsey Park a bit of a fortress. We don't want to take away our strengths to cover theirs. We respect the combination of Stewart and Gill immensely but we think our best football is good enough as well. We will have to be smart and try avoid kicking down the line. We want to be bold and take the game on. It is hugely important for both teams and we are ready to get back to the basics and play a solid four quarters.

Wallan: Riddell have a great list and have recruited well. They are always hard to beat at home too. I thought our boys started strong and we managed to get out to a three-goal lead in the second quarter but to Riddells credit, they kicked some red time goals and the match was fairly even at third time. They gained the momentum in the third but we didn't give up and finished off well. They are a good side, with a terrific coach. We look forward to playing Romsey this week. It's a beautiful ground and we felt like we let one slip in round one, we held a 26 point lead that day but unfortunately fell away from our structures. The ladder is tight. This shapes as a mini final.

Players to watch

Romsey: From all reports Nathan Rayment will be on the sidelines this week opening up an opportunity for someone to stand up in the middle of the ground for the Redbacks.

‘Be a Champ’

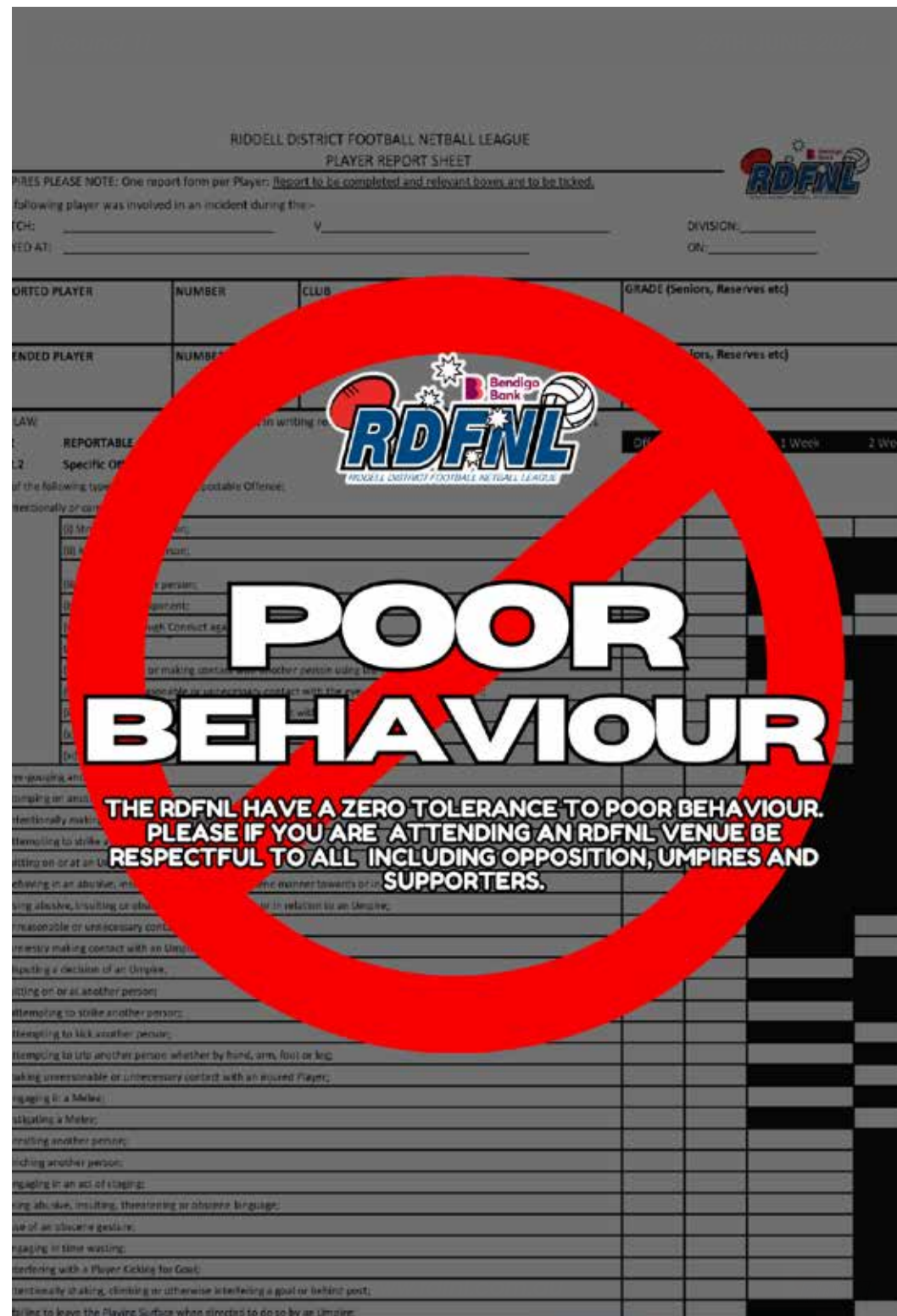

What is Tackle Your Feelings?

- Being referred to as a ‘champ’ is not always cast in a positive way, so Tackle Your Feelings is looking to reclaim the phrase and spin it around to celebrate these people who often don’t get the recognition they deserve with the role they play at their clubs
 - We want players, coaches, committee members, support staff and umpires to be a champ and book their club in for a Tackle Your Feelings workshop
 - Clubs can register for a workshop at **tyfo.tackleyourfeelings.org.au/login/**.
- Adam Baldwin, Program Manager said: “Clubs are beginning to understand their responsibility to create an environment which supports the mental health of their players. We want clubs to prioritise mental health in the same way they currently do physical health. Tackle Your Feelings is a free program that can help clubs kick-start the development of their own mental health game plan.”
- Tackle Your Feelings is a FREE mental health program for community football/netball clubs
 - The program was formed by the AFL Coaches Association, AFL Players’ Association and Zurich Insurance in 2018 following the death of Adelaide coach Phil Walsh
 - The program is delivered by a local psychologist and aims to help participants gain the tools to Understand, Recognise and Respond to signs of mental ill-health.
 - The program is based on the education delivered to the AFL industry and is led by high-profile player and coach ambassadors
 - Since 2019, the TYF program has been delivered to more than 10,000 participants in every Australian state and territory and it’s available to your club in 2024
 - Quote from TYF ambassador Nathan Buckley: “It’s an awesome program. It’s so succinct and gives you really good strategies... it’s a really good conversation starter.”

In the last 10 years, breast cancer diagnosis has increased by 21%. Since the National Breast Cancer Foundation (NBCF) started funding in 1994, the death rates from breast cancer in Australia have reduced by over 40% thanks in large part to research in prevention, early detection and new and improved breast cancer treatments.

So why can focusing on gratitude be so beneficial to you as a netballer?

We'll consider that it is impossible to have two emotions at once. And, the same goes for thoughts for that matter - we can only handle one thought at a time. A few characteristics of grateful netballers ...

Grateful netballers appreciate what they have. While some players complain, make excuses and don't appreciate the fantastic opportunity of sport, grateful players are excited to have the opportunity to play a sport they love and all of the benefits that go with that sport (fitness, relationships, life lessons, joy of winning, the learning from losing and the opportunity to challenge and test your abilities).

Grateful netballers are grateful for competitors

Appreciate your competitors! Competitors can bring out the best in you and without them you do not have the opportunity to play and test your limits. Competitors give you an opportunity to bring out your best. You need your competitors!

Grateful netballers appreciate the journey and struggle

They know that there will be difficulties and netball often goes in cycles. - ups and downs. Grateful players learn from these struggles to always move forward. There is an appreciation in the value of their struggles and an ability to look at the big picture and know there are brighter days ahead.

Grateful netballers enjoy pressure

Is there pressure in sports? Yes! But, grateful players recognize the incredible opportunity they have to demonstrate their skills and test their limits. You play a game you love often with people engaged and cheering what you do. Grateful players appreciate the meaning that pressure gives their experience. They know pressure is a privilege. Grateful players look around and appreciate the challenge that is being given to them.

Grateful netballers do not rely on winning

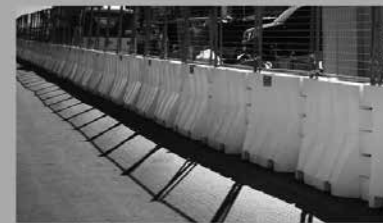
