Macedon vs Kyneton

These two teams have a battle of their own on the ladder and the winner of this will go into the last part of the season as a likely fifth spot in the finals race. Macedon got the win in their last outing and are the team in better form at present. Tigers need everything to go right for them from here and with a depleted list their backs are against the wall.

From the Coaches:

Macedon: I was mostly disappointed with the start of the last. We got ourselves into a position where we were leading at three quarter time. If you offered us that kind of start earlier we would have taken it. We just let them get a couple of early ones in that fourth. It wasn't like we played poorly we just dropped off slightly and you can't really afford to do that. We need to take that next step and beat one of those big three teams we haven't been able to for a number of years now, once we break through once it will be a defining point for our young group. Kyneton this week will be a must win game for both clubs. We got the job done not that long ago so there is no reason why we shouldn't go in confident.

Kyneton: We were dismal. There is no hiding from that. We can't make any excuses when the footy got a bit wet and the stronger bodies started crashing in we rolled over far too easily. That isn't Kyneton football. We want to be better this week. We have a long list of injury and people unavailable but it still wasn't good enough. We get a couple of senior bodies in this week and I am expecting the younger players to get themselves up again. We lose this one and we are as good as done this season.

Players to watch

Macedon: Young Riley Nolan made his debut last week and looked at home in defence.

Kyneton: Caleb Fisher was once again our player of the week for his game in a tough loss at the hands of Riddell. His work rate up and down the ground is second to none in this competition.

Prediction: Macedon to win in a close one.

Melton Centrals vs Romsey

Melton Centrals are fresh off the bye and a win while Romsey have two hard losses in as many weeks. Melton Centrals match up well against Romsey and the previous result will give them some confidence.

From the Coaches:

Melton Centrals: It was great we got th win but we were very lucky. The game was ugly they probably deserved it as much as we did. We were competitive last time we played Romsey but we would need a lot to go our way for us to be there again. We will be without four of our better players and that's going to leave a lot of work for the others. We just don't have the depth but we will go out and give our all for what's left of the season and see if we can pick up a win a long the way.

We want to improve and match it with those teams so we just have to pick ourselves up and get back to what we do best. Players to watch

Wallan vs Diggers Rest

These two teams have had some fantastic rivalries over the years and they have shared the results. Diggers Rest have the silverware in the cabinet but Wallan have always been knocking on the door and this time the Magpies will go in as favourites. Wallan picked up two key players on the even of the transfers closing and both Jake Carlisle and John Bellino will be tough match ups.

From the Coaches:

Wallan: It was a good win on the weekend, in very wet conditions. The ladder is tight, so it proved a crucial game for both clubs. Jake Carlisle played well on debut & had an impact with Chris Stewart in the Ruck. The wet conditions suited Corey Viani, who is as tough as they come. Jacob Langborne, Sean Morris, Matt Perri & Reuben Rode all contributed to the win. We have had some epic battles with Diggers over the past few seasons & I expect the same fierce contest on Saturday. They are the reigning premiers, with a talented list, so it should be another great game.

Players to watch

We are in really good shape and really happy with how we are travelling. We have great support and good culture and it just seems to be working. As we reach the pointy end of the season what is the best way to manage court time and are we prepared for finals? Do we understand the league by laws surrounding player qualifications?

Is there anything more widely discussed amongst coaches, netballers and their families (and that causes more angst) than the issue of court time?

From players' first forays into the game as seven or eight-year-olds, right up to elite state and national competitions, it's unquestionably the single biggest point of contention, week in and week out.

So what's the right approach when it comes to the court time that players receive? Many clubs have different policies that may or may not work for them, however there are some approaches that undoubtedly work better than others.

TRAINING COMES FIRST

It's amazing how often some players will be unwell or injured for a weekend training session, and yet never fail to be available for a game.

Giving those players the same court time as their teammates sends a message that training isn't important and that there is no reward for players who put in the effort each and every week.

It's important to set rules and guidelines around team expectations at the start of the season and inform both players and parents about them, and then follow through on those expectations throughout the year.

If a player consistently misses training, however, there's cause to suggest that they shouldn't receive any court time until their attendance improves and they can demonstrate commitment to the team.

It shouldn't be seen as a punishment for players who don't attend training, but rather a reward for the players who do attend training and have shown commitment to the team and their teammates.

When explaining this to the affected player and their parents, it's important to note that at training sessions the team works on strategies, structures and on-court team chemistry, and that when players miss training it impacts the ability of every other player in the team to put those newly learned and practised skills out on court.

Of course, sometimes there are extenuating circumstances, like a family emergency, however if players know the guidelines and you're consistent in the application of those guidelines, it's likely you'll have all of your players at training the vast majority of the time.



ROMSEY DENTAL NETBALL REPORT

COURT TIME ISN'T EVERYTHING

It's important to remember that being on the court on match night isn't the only place where development happens. In a 40-minute game of netball, a player might touch the ball 80-100 times if they play all four quarters. Let's say that's two seconds per possession, so you're looking at a maximum of about two-and-a-half minutes to three-and-a-half minutes in which a player will actually have their hands on the ball, across a whole game. Obviously there is movement and body positioning and other non-ball factors that are also involved in playing a game, however in terms of passing and ball skills, those couple of minutes are all you get. At training, on the other hand, a player might handle the ball 80-100 times in a single 10-minute drill, if they're completing pair work with a partner. That's why we always stress to players the importance of completing each pass or skill properly, with good technique and with good intensity, at training – because that's the real opportunity to develop and improve, rather than purely on game day. It's about creating good habits and techniques so that when that player receives those 20-odd possessions in a quarter during their weekly game, they can execute the pass or skill required on as many of them as possible, thus giving themselves a greater chance of remaining on the court and receiving more court time.

SHOULD EVERYONE RECEIVE EQUAL COURT TIME?

Each club should have a policy that provides guidance for coaches around court time. Having a firm policy will also assist coaches when players or parents approach you to ask those inevitable questions.

We've always aimed to keep court time relatively even, however that's not to say it needs to be. Players should earn their court time, and shouldn't receive it as a matter of course.

It's up to the coach to provide feedback and learning opportunities for players at both games and training, but it's up to the player to take on that instruction and put it out on court. If they don't utilise that feedback to improve, or don't attempt to try what the coach has suggested, why should they receive the same court time as other players who do?

By law 16 – Player Qualification - Seniors

- (a) All other eligibility criteria and player registration rules and by-laws must be followed.
- (b) Players may play a maximum of 2 matches per round, during the home and away season with their club in any grade, subject to part (e).
- (c) A player who has played more than one match in a round in a day shall only have their higher match recorded as match played when determining finals eligibility. The second match will not count when determining finals eligibility. A 19 & Under player will have the underage & the senior grade match recorded as qualification matches for both age group/grade.
- (d) Any team may list up to 12 players in any one match, and there will be no limit on the number of substitutions made.
- (e) Any player who has played six (6) matches in a higher grade, cannot play in a lower grade for the remainder of the season (except 19 & Under players refer to 16(c)).

If a player is found to have played a game in lower grade after they have already played 6 games in higher grade they will lose premiership points for that round and the club will be fined \$100.00.

- (f) Players must take the court in the match for it to be counted as a qualifying game. Players who remain on the interchange bench shall not have the match recorded as a qualifying game.
- (g) Players in all grades must play at least four (4) matches in that season in one grade/age group to be eligible to participate in that grade's final series.
- (h) A player can only play in one (1) finals match on the same weekend except for players in the 19 & Under competition who can play in two (2) matches maximum on the same weekend, as long as they have met the qualification requirements as stated in 16 (g).
- (i) Any player that has played in a higher level than A Grade, e.g. Suncorp Super Netball Competition, Australian Netball League or the Victorian Netball League within the past 12 months will only be permitted to play no lower than A Grade in the RDFNL competition, except if they are a 19 & under player, who are eligible to play in any grade.

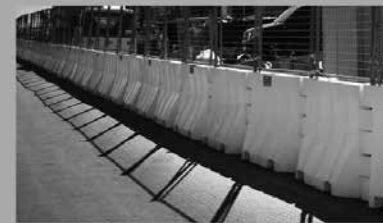
