These ceremonies will be delivered by elders from the Wurundjeri and Taungurung lands.

Each of the senior netball and football games through this round will be played with balls encompassing Indigenous artwork provided through Sherrin and Netball Victoria.

We sincerely thank Greater Western Water for getting behind this initiative and for their long-term support of netball in the RDFNL.

A massive thank you to Grant McMillan for working behind the scenes to make this weekend happen.

Diggers Rest vs Lancefield

The tale of two teams couldn't be any more different for Diggers Rest and Lancefield. Diggers Rest come into this one on the back of arguably their most impressive performance this season while Lancefield were forced to make changes after their coach stood down prior to the bye. Will Lancefield come out all guns blazing this weekend.

From the Coaches:

Diggers Rest: We played really well. We have had to use a few older blokes to cover injuries and we have been lucky to get two wins. We know it was a good win because Ben Morse actually smiled and when that happens we all smile a bit bigger. Hopefully we get some injured players back over the next couple of weeks. Lancefield have been close without getting the result. They have definitely improved and they pushed us early this year. We have plenty to work on and we want to continue to build on the momentum we take from beating a good team on their home ground. Shout out to Jeff Heritage on playing his 300th club game.

Lancefield (Andrew McTrusty): We definitely came to a fork in the road we weren't expecting but we have everyone on the same page and we want to finish the season strong and build towards 2025. We don't want to waste the next few games we have changed our playing style a little bit to suit the personnel and we meet a red hot Diggers Rest. It was great to have so much support last week on the week of the bye at our 19s game as they broke an 11 year drought. Our reserves have also won a couple and the feeling around the club is positive.

Players to watch

Diggers Rest: Campbell Wearne has really settled into RDFNL competition now and his connection with ruck Hayden Davis is improving each week.

Lancefield: Riley O'Meara has been the stand out player for the Tigers up until this point of the season. Will his form continue into the back end of the season?

Prediction: Diggers Rest to get a big win over Lancefield.

Kyneton vs Melton Centrals

Kyneton were well and truly in the contest against Macedon and even led late but it wasn't to be for them. Equally Melton Centrals competed early but were out played in the second half against Romsey. Which team will stand up this weekend as they are both capable.

From the Coaches:

Kyneton: It is disappointing to be in another game and fall just short. We had a good chat about being tougher above our shoulders and we did the hard work. Kicked two early in the fourth and they thought the job was done. Macedon played really well. It was a hard contested game but it is a game we needed to win if we are a realistic chance of playing finals. We want to bounce back this weekend and start playing some consistent football. We played well to beat Romsey, had a shocker against Riddell, competitive in patches against Macedon. We need four quarters and we need to get a win on the board.

Melton Centrals: Our backs have been really good and our mids are winning the clearance but it is a lack of effort from the forwards. They want silver service and when they don't get it they stand there and complain. We need to see some more second and third efforts when the ball hits the deck because at the minute it goes in and it comes out just as fast. We are continuously burning our back line by putting them under so much pressure. We wanted effort for the Darren Weavell so any past player could say at least they have a crack. We did that. That was one positive. Kyneton have some really good players but we were competitive last time and if there is a bit a rain on the way you never know. We will get a couple of players this week so adding a mid to the group might mean we can rotate a mid forward, maybe we can send our defenders back. We have to try something to give us a bit of a lift in the forward half of the ground.

Players to watch

Kyneton: Caleb Fisher dominated when these teams met last. Kicked five and did damage across the ground. Centrals will look to make his day a bit more difficult the second time around.

Melton Centrals: Jake Armistead was this weeks player of the week for his 38 touches nine clearances and plenty of inside 50 and rebound 50s in the loss to Romsey.

Prediction: Kyneton to get back on the winners list. Tigers should be able to open he game up on the bigger ground and run Melton Centrals out of the contest.

Riddell vs Macedon

From the Coaches:

Riddell: We definitely didn't play our best but it was good to see Woodend Heskett with a few mostly young kids who are really talented in their line up. They didn't allow us to play as well as we would have liked. They were very hard at the footy and their pressure was excellent Woodend Heskett are better than their results. We need to put four better quarters together this weekend. We are still on top of the ladder but this competition is so tight and you can't afford to have a lousy week.

Macedon: We are always pleased to get a win. It was an intense game. There was tension across the ground and that led to a contested brand of football. It was hard fought and they got back in front but credit to our group they found a way to overcome the challenge. We haven't been out of a game yet this season. A big win isn't too far away and we will go into every game with the belief we can win and push the top three teams. Riddell at Riddell is going to be tough they play well most weeks and they play even better at home. Any win at Gilbert Gordon is impressive it is so hard to win there they will be ready to play again this weekend. We had two players in two weeks make their debut so we will continue to use our youth and give these great kids an opportunity at senior level.

Players to watch

From the Coaches:

Having 17 players on the ground for 15 minutes obviously impacted us structurally in the last quarter but full credit to Lobby and the Diggers boys. WOMEN'S FOOTBALL ROUND 11 RDFNL PREVIEWS with Grace Bibby

With just three games remaining the competition for the four points is tight especially in the middle of the ladder where a finals position is still on the line.

Lancefield vs Romsey

These two teams are coming from a long way back but there is something exciting when they match up. Two teams separated by 10 kilometres and yet the fiercest of rivals on field and friends off it.

Lancefield: Lancefield have the upper hand in the contest as they won their earlier encounter. Lancefield have been really competitive in most games but have been unable to make teams pay by hitting the scoreboard. They have been led all season long by Chloe Hodgson who racks up possessions for fun. Lancefield will think two wins in their first season would be relatively successful given how tight the competition is. If they can find some support in the middle of the ground and shoulder the workload, they will go a long way to recording their second win. Lancefield have had a bye so it is always interesting to see how teams respond re they fresh with no injuries or are they sluggish from not playing for a fortnight?

Romsey: For the Redbacks they have had another tough season and they will get themselves up for this game as it is a realistic chance of taking the points against a team who is at a similar stage. Romsey will know if they can convert their hard work and pressure into scores that they will be in the contest. We expect a low scoring affair which will suit Romsey and even though they haven't been kicking goals they are starting to get their hands on the football more and have more shots on goal.

Players to watch

Lancefield: Chloe Hodgson is the difference maker for the Tigers if she gets plenty of the ball they will win comfortably.

Romsey: Whether it is a team effort or one specific player the Redbacks need to stay on top of Hodgson and stifle her impact.

Prediction: Lancefield to record their second win and leave the Redbacks winless.

Macedon vs Melton

Macedon are sitting pretty at the top of ladder but things haven't been as smooth sailing for Melton. Melton will play finals but a scalp here would give them some certainty heading into the last two rounds.

Macedon: Macedon are yet to put a foot wrong this season and they are going from strength to strength. It was a classy performance with winners all over the ground against Romsey. They have found some strong bodies to build the team around and it has allowed the young guns to develop into fantastic players at their own pace. After some time in the ruck last season Lilli Collins has played a more midfield high forward role this season

and is flourishing. Macedon have shared the workload around with Lulu Slater and Ruby Watts also playing well. They will be hard to beat this weekend and even harder to beat the closer they are to a premiership.

Melton: Melton moved into third spot on the ladder with a win over Mount Alexander while it wasn't a huge margin and they were more than competitive it was a win just the same. Melton had plenty of the football and were able to control the game with marks and maintaining the football. The Bloods would love a scalp to give their group some belief heading into finals.

Players to watch

Macedon: Lilli Collins was the player of the week this week dominating in their win over Romsey.

Melton: Chelsey Lapsley is a little pocket rocket for the Bloods. She loves a contested possession and has had a strong month of football.

Prediction: Macedon to keep their perfect record in tact and record a big win over Melton.

Woodend Hesket vs Mt Alexander

What an exciting game this will be. Looking at result and margins most would expect Woodend Hesket to win this one but they are currently on the same number of points and games won and loss. Woodend Hesket win and finals look like a tough ask for the Falcons. The Falcons win and Woodend Hesket are up against it. Whoever wins will be knocking on the door of Melton who would be the underdogs in their contest with Macedon.

Woodend Hesket: Woodend Hesket have a healthy percentage in the league but the younger players have struggled in big games and their wayward kicking can be costly. They have the better skillset but will they be able to keep their composure in a big game?

There was just one kick in the final margin. The Falcons looked at their best when they ran and linked up but they struggled to take marks and maintain possession. The brand of football they are playing is exciting to watch and their growth in the competition from being a team down the bottom to pushing for finals is very exciting for their small club and our league. Well done to all involved at the Mount Alexander Football Club.

Players to watch

Woodend Hesket: Mariam Habib has been the best of the young Hawks team with her run out of defence. She will be a key player against the stronger more mature Falcons bodies this week.

Mount Alexander: Jesse Boyland was the best for the Falcons last week with 16 disposals and 100 ranking points.

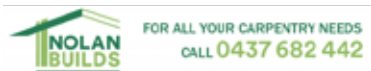

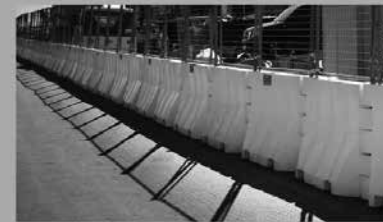
