Lancefield vs Romsey

These two teams often bring there best for the rivalry and we are expecting big things again this weekend. Romsey are coming in fresh from the Bye where Lancefield were less than impressive against Lancefield. Lancefield are still chasing their first win and this would be a big one for them.

From the Coaches

Lancefield: It wasn't a great result and wasn't what we intend to bring. Every time we go out there hoping to win and it is always disappointing when you don't. We are ready to knuckle down and redeem in the last few rounds of the competition. We still think a win is possible but we need to put four quarters together. At times this year we have matched it with every team but we haven't got a win on the board yet. We are hopeful of a better performance this weekend. We don't want to sit back and waste what's left of the year. We are as hungry now as we have been all season.

Romsey: It was nice to fresher up. We had a few players sick and injured so to come in fresh and really hit the last six games at 100 percent is important to us. Players to watch

From the Coaches



Mount Alexander vs Macedon

Mount Alexander: Mount Alexander have been knocking on the door of a big scalp but have been unable to get it done so far this season. With a bye in the final round of the home and away season thi will be the last time we see the Falcons in action. They have had an up and down season with their results but they overall have played a more competitive brand of football and have started to challenge the top end teams more consistently. Players to watch

Lancefield vs Melton

It was wonderful to have the Wallan Junior Football Club mascots back again. Especially the young mascot who had carefully saved a Jake Carlisle footy card and brought it along for a treasured signature.

The Reserves number one mascot and supporter had the biggest smile on his face as he asked all the Reserves to sign his treasured football.

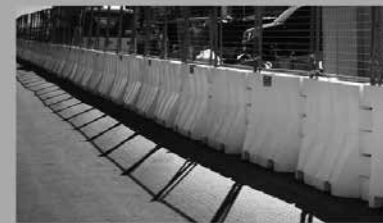
