Kyneton vs Lancefield

A game that a couple of weeks ago you would have said it could go either way but after knocking off Diggers Rest last weekend the Kyneton Tigers are the informed team. Lancefield were also really good in trying conditions against Macedon but the elusive first win of the season is still being hunted.

From the Coaches

Kyneton: We are so happy with how we went about it. We knew they had some internal battles the same as every club does but we were quietly confident. We wanted to get a good start so they didn't have the chance to put last week behind them straight away. We played really good football and didn't allow them back into the contest. The weather certainly helped us. We are not a skillful team we don't rely on skills we play a territory game and just take the grass in front of us. When we played Lancefield last time, we weren't ready to play but now every week is a fine we need to keep the foot down and if we are winning win well.

Lancefield: The game was over in the first 10 minutes but we fought bravely to stay in it. We played some really good football in patches. We are confident if our effort is there it doesn't matter the size of the ground or the conditions our best is good enough and we will back the boys in. Players to watch

Macedon vs Kyneton

Macedon will go into this contest as favourites but finals are a different ball games. During the season the teams met on two occasions. In the first encounter Macedon had more scoring shots but were unable to make the most of their opportunities and they split the points. In their second match up it was one way traffic and the Cats had a point to prove notching up a big win. Having both played in the grand final last season both groups will have some finals experience so it will be interesting to see who settles first and gets an early lead.

Macedon: Macedon were the big improvers last season and have continued on their merry way in season 2024. The recruiting in the off season has no doubt helped but the players of last season have benefitted from a season of football as well. Macedon are yet to lose a game and outside of the draw again Kyneton they haven't really felt any pressure on the scoreboard. It would take something pretty drastic to knock this team off over the next three weeks.

Kyneton: Kyneton have had a strong season with just one loss coming in round 8. Unfortunately that loss was a big one at the hands of the team they meet today. Kyneton have been a powerhouse in the competition for two seasons and have suffered just one loss in that time. They have been known for their quick transition from half back and putting big scores on the board. Their good players have stood up and taken charge and in a final you would expect them to go to another level. Having tasted premiership glory last season they won't die wondering during this finals series.

Players to watch

Kyneton: Teagan Ainslie was best on ground in their final match of the season and the captain has been a solid contributor all season long.

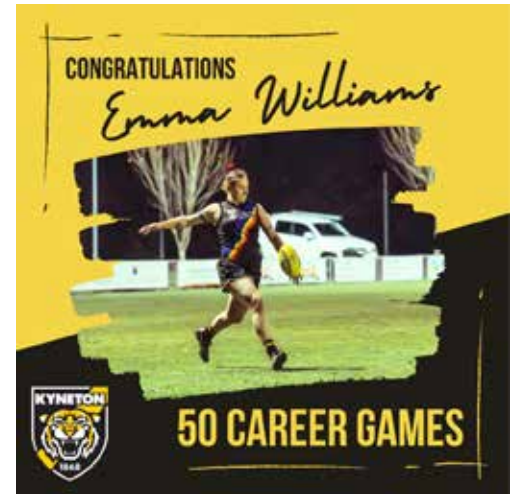

Use these techniques to guide you through training as you work to get better each and every day. Maintain the progress, stay consistent, and you'll certainly be successful.

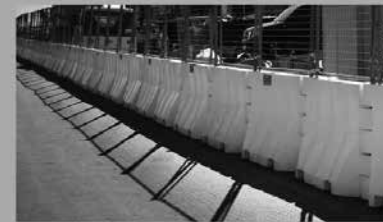

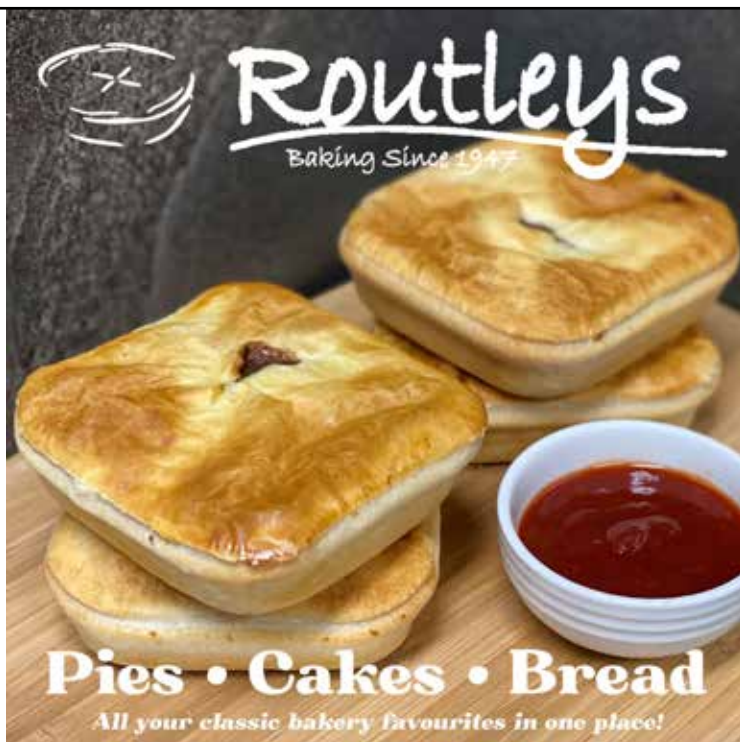
