Melton Centrals vs Macedon

Macedon are facing do or die games most weeks and this is one they will be banking on. For Melton Centrals they have battled this year but their list is looking as good as it has done all season and they will be looking to cause some chaos for other clubs now that they know their season has just two games remaining.

From the Coaches

Melton Centrals: We started okay but we just didn't make the most of our opportunities then they create a turn over and we get scored against going the other way. It is an area we need to be better in. We had a lot of positives though. Evan Donohue got through his first game back and Sam Apineru was fantastic in the ruck against a quality opponent. We only have two games left but this one is in front of our centurion club members so we want to put on a good showing for them because they are the ones that give back to the club.

Macedon: It was a really pleasing win for us. It gives the group a bit more belief heading into the last couple of rounds. The dryer surface allowed us to play our default style of football and they showed just how good they can be. We will take full confidence into this weekend but we know Centrals are tough and play their ground pretty well. No game is easy and when you are fighting for your finals spot you have to make sure of them. Over the course of the season we have blooded many young players and on the weekend we have the most we have had all year with nine teenagers on the ground. There are a couple in there that their magnets are the first on the board each week. We might have some headaches at selection but we are really happy with our youth coming through and how our list is looking. Massive shout out to our reserves who had a good win. They have battled all season long and I think used about 80 guys through the team so for them to get a win and for our senior women to go through to another grand final is so exciting. We can't wait to support our women next weekend.

Players to watch

Melton Centrals: Sam Apineru has been in fantastic form and he is linking up well with the likes of Armistead, Roberts and the Thornton Gielan brothers.

Macedon: Brad Cooke bobbed up and kicked six on the weekend including five first half goals. Will he make his way back inside the forward 50 as his brother is still sidelined with a calf injury.

Prediction: Macedon to record a really strong win and move one step closer to finals football in season 2024.

Romsey vs Diggers Rest

If recent results are anything to go by this game will be highly anticipated. Both teams have been dealt big losses at the hands of the Bombers while Kyneton also got on top of the Burras. Winning form is good form and both clubs will be desperate to get the four points and the likelihood of sewing up a top three finish.

From the Coaches

Romsey: They were very very good. We tried a few things and nothing went our way. They had all the answers. The result wasn't from a lack of trying or effort they were simply too good. We believe they are the bench mark and if that is the blueprint for winning a grand final we certainly have some work to do. Like most teams Diggers Rest have stars across the board and we will have some plans in place but first and foremost we want to get back to playing four strong quarters of our style of football. Every game is a final for us and the top three finish is so important. We played in the elimination final last year and it's too hard to come from that far back we need to win this weekend and give ourselves every chance.

Diggers Rest: The break came at a really good time for us we had injuries and we weren't playing good football. We had the chance to reset and work on some things and I think we will be better placed to finish the season now. Romsey play well against us always so we know it will be a tough game but we just need to control what we can do with the football. We weren't smart last time we played Romsey so we need to make sure we are making better decision this time around. We know our best football can beat anyone and we are confident our best is still ahead of us.

Players to watch

Romsey: Chris Petraro has been sidelined for the last couple of weeks with a calf strain. He is important in the middle of the ground for the Redbacks.

Diggers Rest: It has been a while since we have seen Mitch Jensen in the senior line up but he is fit and raring to go again and will add some depth to the Burras whether he plays in defence or forward of the football.

Prediction: Diggers Rest to bounce back with a win in the dryer conditions at Romsey Park.

Players to watch

Kyneton vs Woodend Hesket

Just one more task for these two teams to make it to the last day of the senior womens season.

Kyneton wouldn't have felt pressure like this is their first two seasons in the RDFNL while Woodend Hesket held their nerve to kick a late goal to seal the victory over Melton Bloods.

Last week Macedon easily accounted for Kyneton to book their spot on grand final day.

These two teams have met twice during the season with Kyneton winning both times. Kyneton easily account for Woodend Hesket in their most recent encounter but back in round four the margin was just seven points in favour of the Tigers.

Have the Hawks got one last challenge to book a spot in the senior womens grand final or will we see a repeat of last years grand finalist?

Kyneton: It was another tough game for Tigers who just don't seem to match up well against the Cats this season. Macedon have had their measure on multiple occasions this season but their form outside of playing against the Cats has been strong.

Kyneton still have plenty of depth and if they can get a few players back in for the preliminary final they may have more avenues to scoring and kick a winning score.

Their strength is winning the ball out of the middle and getting the ball forward but they just haven't been able to find the same potency around the big sticks as they have done previously.

Kyneton went through from the qualifying final last year so playing a do or die final will no doubt create some nerves in the group.

Woodend Hesket: Woodend Hesket won their way through to the preliminary final with a hard fought win over Melton. Last season Melton progressed through to the prelims but Woodend Hesket had other ideas in their second season.

All season long Woodend Hesket have been competitive around the ground but have been poor when it comes to converting their opportunities.

If they can kick straight and put a couple of early goals on the board and use some scoring pressure to their advantage Kyneton may not be able to find the answer.

Players to watch

Kyneton: We highlighted Teagna Ainslie as a player to watch last week and she was this weeks player of the week. We know how much Teagan loves playing on a big occasion and if the Tigers are going to make a second consecutive grand final she will need to be at her best.

Woodend Hesket: Harmony Cassar has had a fantastic season for the Hawks. Coming off the half back line Cassar has been able to influence contests all over the ground and the ability to win the ball and get the Hawks into attack is growing week by week.

Prediction: Kyneton to win in a close one. Our first lot of football extra time is on the cards in this one.
