Macedon vs Mount Alexander

Macedon: Macedon had a strong start to the season easily accounting for Woodend Heskett in round 1. They play a fast free flowing game of football and very rarely will they take a big contested mark in their forward fifty. The Cats rely on their pressure and getting the ball going back their way. It will be a big day for the Cats as they play alongside their netball and football on the biggest day of the year at Tony Clarke.

Mount Alexander: While disappointed to lose to Kyneton Mount Alexander would have been happy to be far more competitive across the ground. All the stats indicated the game was closer than the scoreline suggested.

The Mount Alexander players have certainly shown they have improved from last season and will be no easy beat this year.

They played in the Pride Cup last week and an Anzac Day clash will be another big occasion for the club.

Players to watch

Macedon: Briana Woodburn had 25 possessions and kicked two goals in the Cats season opener.

Mount Alexander: Tash Ross Harris collected another 40 possessions this week and is a clear stand out player of the competition.

Prediction: *Macedon to get a big win over the Falcons in front of a big home crowd.*

Lancefield vs Kyneton

Lancefield: In their first game in the competition Lancefield certainly came to play. They were strong around the contest and weren't scared to put their bodies on the line. They will continue to improve this season but it was a solid start. They will be thrust into some elite level football this week when they take on the reigning premiers Kyneton.

Kyneton: Kyneton did a really good job of punishing Mount Alexander on their turnovers last

week. Against a new team such as Lancefield if they can create turnovers and score quickly that will go a long way to them winning.

Players to watch

Lancefield: Emily O'Brien was a tackling machine in round one.

Kyneton: Belinda Hateley has a quieter start to the season than last year but the stats showed she was still an important player in their win over Mount Alexander. Teagan Ainslie was awarded best on ground.

Prediction: *Kyneton to take the chocolates against Lancefield on a special day for both packs of Tigers.*

Melton vs Woodend Heskett

Melton: The signs are either really good for Melton or not great for Romsey as Melton never gave them an inch. Keeping the Redbacks scoreless would have been great for the Bloods and they will take that confidence into this weekend's match.

TACKLE YOUR FEELINGS



Essendon are partnering with the Tackle Your Feelings (TYF) program to make mental health training available to community coaches, in 2022. Tackle Your Feelings is a free mental health training program for community AFL coaches, as well as committee members and other club support staff. The program is delivered by a local psychologist and aims to help participants gain the tools to Understand, Recognise and Respond to signs of mental ill-health in their players. In 2021, the program was delivered to more than 4000 community coaches from 352 clubs across every Australian state and territory. 'Tackle your Feelings' was inspired by mental health education developed for AFL professional coaches and players, consisting of a face-to-face presentation from a local psychologist and additional online learning. Ambassadors include Leon Cameron, Alastair Clarkson, Nathan Buckley, Neville Jetta, Kara Antonio and Dylan Buckley also feature throughout

the video content within the program. The program was formed by the AFL Coaches Association, AFL Players' Association and Zurich Insurance in 2018, after the tragic death of Adelaide coach Phil Walsh three years earlier.

How your club can get involved

Tackle Your Feelings is a free program and is available to your club in 2022.

Once coaches complete the training (workshop and online modules) they will have access to resources including blogs, podcasts and videos to assist with their ongoing learning. Participating clubs are eligible for the Tackle Your Feelings rewards program, which includes footballs, equipment and access to program ambassadors.

Club Notes

Today Lancefield hosts our biggest event of the year when we play Kyneton in the first 'Clash of the Tigers' at Lancefield Park for ANZAC Day. It's the first time the two Tigers have played each other since Kyneton joined the RDFNL although accounts of games between Lancefield and some of Kyneton's earlier teams date back to the 1880's.

Lancefield will don a special ANZAC jumper and netball dress to pay tribute to service men and women both past and present who served our nation including 14 Lancefield players who went to war and never returned home. Through research from the Romsey Lancefield Historical Society in writing the clubs 150th anniversary book last year 14 players were identified that were killed in action. As a tribute to those players and their sacrifice the Lancefield players, in seniors football and A grade netball, will carry those players names on a wattle inspired one off tribute jumper and dress. The wattle is a significant symbol of Australia particularly through the war years. During World War 1 sprigs of wattle were sent in letters to soldiers as a reminder of home while boxes filled with sprigs of wattle were sent to hospitals for the wounded soldiers in Egypt, France and England. Meanwhile back at home the Red Cross sold wattle sprigs to raise money for the war effort. The symbolism and attachment to wattle in our sporting landscape is summed up in no better manner than by the famous line in the Australian cricket teams victory song, "Under the Southern Cross I stand, a sprig of wattle in my hand."

The Romsey Lancefield Historical Society will be on hand during the day selling copies

of, not just, the acclaimed Lancefield Football Club 150 year history book, but also the poignant book Anzac Letters that includes letters received by Lancefield families and friends from soldiers serving in WW1. Following the seniors match a function in the Laurie Green Pavilion will see a silent auction take place with the opportunity to take home a timeless piece of LFNC memorabilia with the game day jumpers and dresses offered up for sale. There will also be a major charity fundraiser with a one-off framed copy of the official commemorative jumper, including some very special touches paying tribute to those players from Lancefield that never came home. 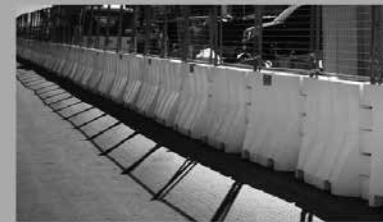
