Diggers Rest vs Romsey

What a contest this is shaping up to be. Diggers Rest arguably premierships favourites and Romsey not far behind. The Redbacks have a way of finding their best football against the Burras and after several close losses in recent years they will want to turn the result around.

From the Coaches:

Diggers Rest: It is definitely a danger game for us. They always play really well against us and they have a good list in good form. It is always a close match up and a good spectacle. After taking some injuries into our last game we have tightened up how we manage our playing group and we won't be making that same mistake again. We will have a couple of changes to our team this week. We will have to play our best to get the job done.

Romsey: They have had our measure in the last couple of years and even though they are good games we have been on the wrong end of it. We want to turn it around. It was a tough loss against Riddell a few weeks ago and we have taken a lot out of it and have had two good wins since and playing arguably our best four quarters. We have had a good start to the season and what better way to test ourselves to start the second stage of the comp than against a team that have great players across the ground. We want to stick to what we know best and what has got us this far. We are a young group and we really want to be consistent across the four and see where that leaves us.

Players to watch

Diggers Rest: With a few key players missing Diggers Rest might use their swingman Jensen in the forward line this week.

Romsey: Petraro is a strong body bull in the midfield who gets plenty of the football and often send the Redbacks into attack.

Prediction: Diggers Rest to record another strong win over a competition finals contender.

From the Coaches:

Melton Centrals are one of those teams that their best is right up there and this is a game we must win so we need to play well.

Riddell vs Lancefield

Not very often the team well clear on the ladder are made a little bit nervous from the underdogs but that could be the case when Riddell take on Lancefield. Lancefield got the win against Riddell last season and have only just finished celebrating. They will be looking to find that kind of form this weekend to cause another big upset.

From the Coaches:

Riddell: We still don't think we are playing our best football and they are definitely better than their scores suggest. We have watched a bit of the footage and they move the ball quite well and have been missing players. We are in a good spot and I haven't had too many coaching decisions to make as players have come in and out but as of this weekend we will be pretty close to full strength which will put some pressure on selections. It is a really good spot to be in. We want to stick to what we have been doing there are things we need to work on we want to play cleaner football and work on our forward connection but it is going okay.

Lancefield: The break came at a really good time for us we have been playing okay but we needed to get some bodied back we have a fair few players coming back in this week. Tom Waters will give us some more first use of the football. Ben Radford, Zach Webb, Adam Miles will all sure us up. We just need to string some good form together and see what happens if we get a couple of wins along the way that will be even better.

Players to watch

Riddell: Kamen Ogilvie has had a really strong season to date and will be looking to continue that form into the second half of the season.

Lancefield: Tom Waters is a star of the competition but a recent injury was close to ending his career. Let's hope he runs this season out with his best form and a few wins.

Wallan vs Kyneton

Heath Shaw may be the big talking point in this one but with or without the former Collingwood star the Magpies will go into this one as favourites. The inclusion of Josh Smith into the Tigers midfield group makes them one of the more attacking mids in the comp. Ethan Foreman leads from the front with Fisher and Smith not far behind.

From the Coaches:

Wallan: It's exciting for the Wallan Community to have Heath Shaw representing the club. 325 AFL games, Premiership, All Australian. he has achieved so much in footy and it will be a great experience for our players. Kyneton have a strong leader in charge, I was lucky to spend some time with Ethan during the Interleague program and he reads the game well. Huntley is a star and Fisher is extremely talented. Plus the new addition of Josh Smith. They are a good side. It's our first ever encounter with Kyneton. It's going to be a fierce contest and hopefully we can get a big crowd at Greenhills Reserve on Saturday.

Macedon vs Kyneton

We know these two teams are the best in the competition. They were last years grand finalist and have been the two most impressive so far this season. Their last game they split the points and we expect this contest to be another cracker.

Macedon: Macedon are knocking on the door of being the first team to defeat Kyneton. Last time they met Macedon had more shots at goal and more of the football but couldn't make the most of their opportunities and secure the four points. Macedon did a great job winning the football out of the middle of the ground despite losing the hit outs. Macedon play their best football when they can get the ball moving forward and speed is on the game.

Kyneton: Kyneton are much better possession team they control the tempo and control possession. They have many players in their team with strong hands and often lead the contested marking stat line. Since they were challenged in round five they have played better football and they will be hoping the break doesn't stop their momentum.

Players to watch

Macedon: Lilli Collins is an important player not only in the ruck but all over the ground for Macedon. If he can play well the team generally follows.

Kyneton: Teagan Ainslie was best on ground last time they met and her season has been super consistent.

Prediction: *Kyneton to record a win and put some space back between them and their challengers.*

Melton vs Lancefield

Both these teams need a win and some belief. They have each been competitive in some games and fallen well short in others. We know Lancefield are new to the competition but this will be a scalp they are confident they can lock away.

Melton: Melton's form has been inconsistent this season after a big win over Woodend Hesket we thought they were back to their best but a heavy loss at the hands of Macedon last week sees them return with some battle scars. Prediction: *Melton to have a strong win.*

Woodend Hesket vs Romsey

These two teams are yet to play but it would be unlikely the Redbacks have what it takes to compete with the stronger Woodend Hesket. Its been a tough few weeks for Romsey but we are hopeful they will turn it around to finish the season on a high.

Woodend Hesket: Woodend Hesket easily accounted for Lancefield but their kicking accuracy across the ground and in front of the big sticks was a let down. The score line was more flattering for Tigers than the game was competitive but poor kicking kept Lancefield in it.

Romsey: Elise Putyra had five clearances and led every player on the ground in their last game. Lets hope for more of that this week.

Prediction: *Woodend Hesket to record their fourth win of the season.*

TACKLE YOUR FEELINGS



Essendon are partnering with the Tackle Your Feelings (TYF) program to make mental health training available to community coaches, in 2022. Tackle Your Feelings is a free mental health training program for community AFL coaches, as well as committee members and other club support staff. The program is delivered by a local psychologist and aims to help participants gain the tools to Understand, Recognise and Respond to signs of mental ill-health in their players. In 2021, the program was delivered to more than 4000 community coaches from 352 clubs across every Australian state and territory. 'Tackle your Feelings' was inspired by mental health education developed for AFL professional coaches and players, consisting of a face-to-face presentation from a local psychologist and additional online learning. Ambassadors include Leon Cameron, Alastair Clarkson, Nathan Buckley, Neville Jetta, Kara Antonio and Dylan Buckley also feature throughout

the video content within the program. The program was formed by the AFL Coaches Association, AFL Players' Association and Zurich Insurance in 2018, after the tragic death of Adelaide coach Phil Walsh three years earlier.

How your club can get involved

Tackle Your Feelings is a free program and is available to your club in 2022.

Once coaches complete the training (workshop and online modules) they will have access to resources including blogs, podcasts and videos to assist with their ongoing learning. Participating clubs are eligible for the Tackle Your Feelings rewards program, which includes footballs, equipment and access to program ambassadors.

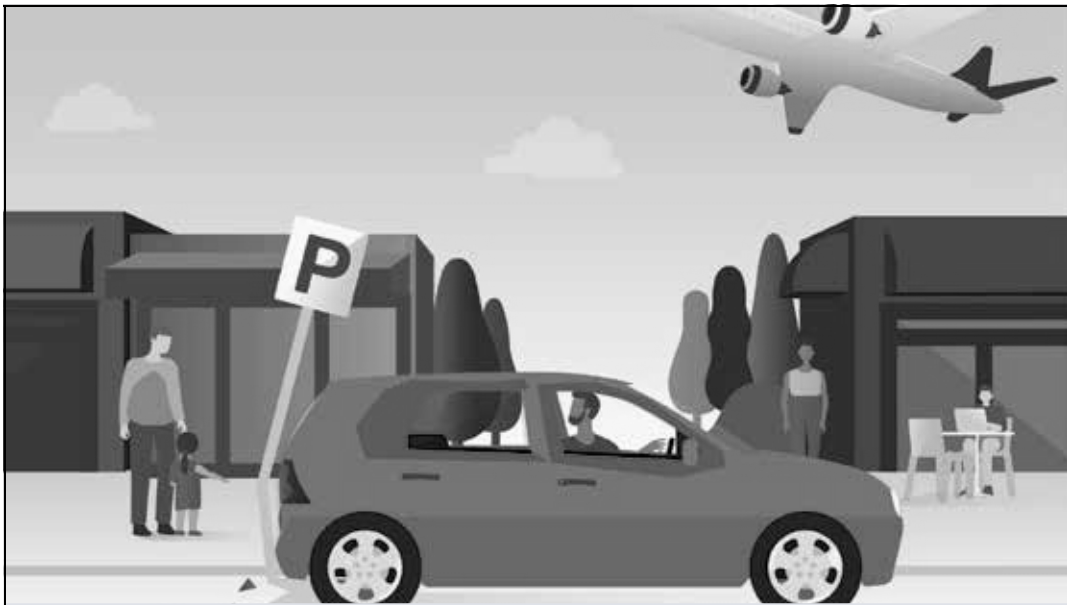

Burnout is real especially if you're an administrator, volunteer or a coach. Administrations, volunteers and coaches understand the 'can't wait for the season to be over' feeling. Sorry everyone else.

I am hoping everyone enjoyed the long weekend and is ready to hit the second half of the season head on with a positive outlook.

The old 'buck stops with us' for results, organising and special requests can be extremely draining.

How can we start preparing for weeks in advance and how do we prevent repeating this same feeling or burning out year after year?

I've got a few tips you might like to try:

1. Say no. If you've been asked to Coach more than one team....think again. Ask yourself, can I give 100% to more than one team? Whatever the outcome, be measured in your answer for 'yes' I can Coach two teams or 'no', I can only Coach one team
2. Organise an amazing Manager. This is one of the best decisions you'll make. Ask someone who is prepared to go above and beyond to make sure all those little things which can end up being huge things are attended to
3. If you are a coach prepare your sessions. Before the season even starts map out your sessions. Eg if you only have one hour per week, then introduce skills that builds the individual and creates a skilled team.
4. If you are an administrator map out your season. What needs to be done at the end of the year that can be in progress during the year, what needs to happen on Saturday/Sunday that I can knock over early in the week.
5. Introduce a Facebook page or WhatsApp for communication with parents/players depending on the age of the players. The more that can be communicated to a group the more time you will save.
6. Upskill. If there are Coach Education Courses on offer, sign up. Point of difference between Coaches that want to improve and those who are babysitting can be in acquiring knowledge. Coach Education is empowering and brings new energy into your Coaching world
7. Control what you can control. If you can't change the outcome don't let it change you. Things are always going to happen outside of your control sometimes it is easier to just go with it than fight it. If you choose to fight it what are you getting out of it?
8. Be kind to yourself. Yes, it's a privilege to Coach players, to be involved in sport but, hey, pat yourself on the back because it is a privilege for them to be Coached by you and for them to turn up each week with equipment, umpires and scorers.

We are now reaching the mid-way point of the season and it is a great time to sit back, watch the smiles on everyone's faces and know you played a part in community sport in 2023.

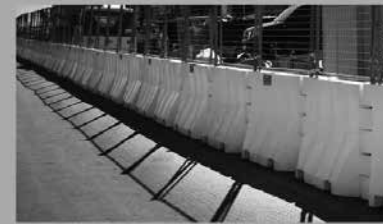

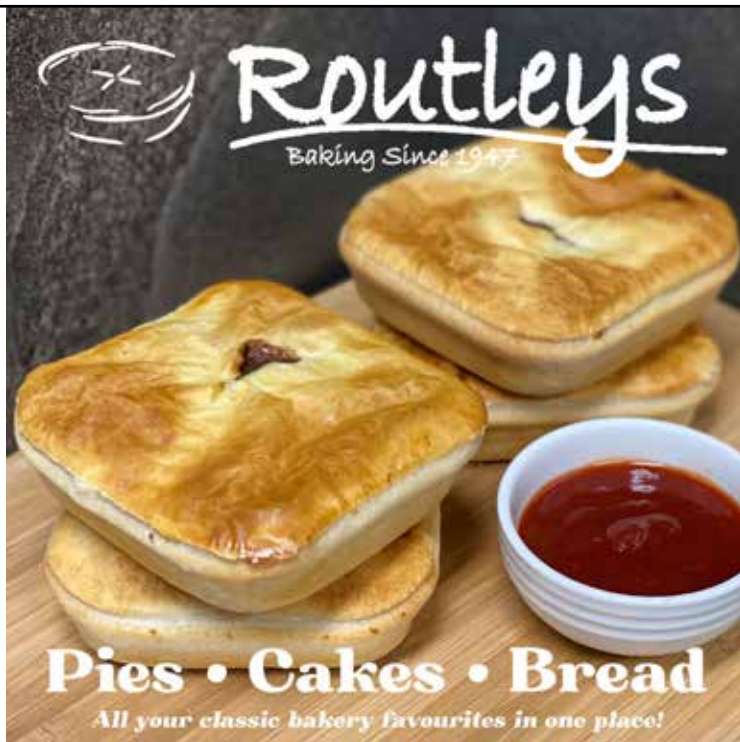
