



RDFNL Senior Mens Previews

All good things must come to an end—and that’s exactly what Round 18 of the RDFNL Home and Away season represents. We’ve seen it all this year: monumental comebacks, upset victories, match-winners after the siren, win streaks that seemed unstoppable, drought-breaking triumphs, and individual brilliance that defied all expectation. And now, all of it comes down to the final round to determine the top six.



This is it for Macedon. A win here and they’re finals-bound. Lose, and their finals fate rests on the outcome of Romsey vs Woodend-Hesket. Make no mistake, this game is Macedon’s to lose. They’ve played solid footy across the back half of the season, finding form at the right time and positioning themselves for a strong finals campaign. But pressure can do strange things, and this game has a pressure gauge turned up to 100. Melton Centrals, meanwhile, have nothing to play for and that makes them dangerous in a different way. After being handed a brutal 107-point lesson by Kyneton last round, you’d hope for a spark of pride to ignite within the group. There’s no expectation, no ladder pressure, and sometimes that’s when a team can surprise you. The challenge for Centrals will be to stay in the contest early. Macedon have had their moments of inaccuracy this season, so if Centrals can apply pressure and make things messy inside 50, who knows? Macedon won’t want to leave their season in someone else’s hands. Expect them to be ruthless.

Prediction: Macedon by 45 points



Another must win game in the final round of season 2025. Romsey simply must win if they want to play finals. They face arguably the best team outside of finals contention in Woodend-Hesket who have been on an absolute tear in the last month, winning 4 of their last 5 matches and are coming in after defeating Riddell by 12 points.

Romsey got the better of Woodend-Hesket earlier in the year in round 6, where they defeated the Hawks by 18 points and the Redbacks will be hoping to repeat history and do their job to secure the 4 points to keep their finals hopes alive.

The forecast is looking set for some wet weather football so this match will be about gaining valuable territory and keeping the ball locked in the attacking half. Hard tackling, tight contests and barely time to get free, this match will have everything to play for and no doubt will go down to the wire.

Prediction: Woodend-Hesket by 5 points.

Wallan would be riding a high like no other after becoming the first team in 2025 to take down Diggers Rest. The Magpies have proven that at their best they can beat anyone, and with only a week out from finals, they will rely on this momentum to carry the group as far as it will take them. That being the case, Wallan are locked in third place. Win, lose or draw, the outcome will not change their finishing position this season. The Gisborne Giants are coming to the end of their inaugural season and what a first season it has been. They have laid the foundation for what will no doubt be a premiership contending side in the next few years. Sure 2 wins on paper may not look like much but they've shown competitiveness personified and they should only get better from here.


Prediction: Wallan by 15 points



Whoever arranged this fixture to leave this match for the last round deserves a promotion. Both Kyneton and Melton South sit on 9 wins and 6 losses in 4th and 5th on the ladder. The winner locks

in finals, while the loser can possibly drop out of finals. Both clubs will have to be at their best out of the middle as well as both groups of forwards. Both clubs are coming off 100+ point wins with massive individual goalkicking efforts with Angus Nolte kicking 8 against the Centrals and Alec Goodson bagging 11 with both men single handedly defeating their opposition off their boot alone. On paper this is such a tight contest and this shows in their corresponding match in round 9 where the Panthers got the job done by 21 points after trailing for majority of the game.

Prediction: Kyneton by 20 points.



To round out the last game of the home and away season, we see top of the ladder Diggers Rest face off against bottom of the ladder Lancefield. The Burra were inflicted their first loss of the season last week against Wallan and while that ruins the possibility of an undefeated run heading into finals, it's hard to imagine there's any stress in the Diggers Rest camp. A win here would be their 14th and confirm their minor premiership status leading into finals. Lancefield enter this match after suffering their worst loss of the season

Prediction: Diggers by 30

RDFNL Senior Womens Previews

It all comes down to this. One game of football and the chance to etch your name into history. On one side stand the Macedon Cats, a powerhouse of RDFNL Women's Football and one of the most dominant outfits in recent memory. Since falling in the 2023 Grand Final, Macedon haven't lost a match – 742 days without defeat, with the only blemish being a draw against Kyneton on May 18th 2024. This is their third straight Grand Final, and they now have the chance to become the first Senior Women's team to go back-to-back, bringing home a second premiership to Tony Clarke Reserve. On the other side are the newcomers – Riddell. In their debut season, the Bombers are one win away from an extraordinary premiership that would place them among the rare teams in Australian sport to claim a flag in their first year. Despite finishing third, the Bombers have proven throughout their finals campaign that their performance throughout the year was anything but a fluke. The two sides have met three times this year, with Macedon claiming victory in all three contests. Their first encounter was Riddell's introduction to the competition, where they were welcomed to the league with a 70-0 masterclass from the Cats. By Round 12, the gap had narrowed to 22 points, and in Round 15, Macedon prevailed by 32. The form line points in Macedon's favour, but anything can happen in a Grand Final! Both teams have shown they can put up big scores, but the forecast is for conditions that will reward territory, contested ball, and defensive pressure.

Both teams are above average with their contest work averaging more than 125 team contested possessions each week. Riddell have the upper hand in the clearance work with on average 2 more clearances than Macedon.

Expect a scrap, where the backlines could decide the outcome. For Macedon, Samantha Pointer and Brianna Woodburn will be pivotal in repelling Riddell's barrage into the forward line, while reigning league best and fairest Ruby Watts and the classy Taya Konias will look to put the ball inside fifty to Charlotte Noonan and co's as much as possible. For Riddell, Lauren Nolan will marshal the backline and must stand tall all game against Macedon's potent attack. Ruby Taranto, Mariam Habib, and Mady Brown will have to nullify the Cats best while finding their own footy and Brianna De Haas and Ruby Ayers will need to capitalise on every scoring chance. Everything points to a fierce, low-scoring contest – one where the smallest moments could decide who raises the cup at the end of the game.

Prediction: Macedon by 8 points.




