RDFNL Senior Women Previews

It all comes down to this. One game of football and the chance to etch your name into history.

On one side stand the Macedon Cats, a powerhouse of RDFNL Women’s Football and one of the most dominant outfits in recent memory. Since falling in the 2023 Grand Final, Macedon haven’t lost a match – 742 days without defeat, with the only blemish being a draw against Kyneton on May 18th 2024. This is their third straight Grand Final, and they now have the chance to become the first Senior Women’s team to go back-to-back, bringing home a second premiership to Tony Clarke Reserve. On the other side are the newcomers – Riddell. In their debut season, the Bombers are one win away from an extraordinary premiership that would place them among the rare teams in Australian sport to claim a flag in their first year. Despite finishing third, the Bombers have proven throughout their finals campaign that their performance throughout the year was anything but a fluke. The two sides have met three times this year, with Macedon claiming victory in all three contests. Their first encounter was Riddell’s introduction to the competition, where they were welcomed to the league with a 70–0 masterclass from the Cats. By Round 12, the gap had narrowed to 22 points, and in Round 15, Macedon prevailed by 32. The form line points in Macedon’s favour, but anything can happen in a Grand Final! Both teams have shown they can put up big scores, but the forecast is for conditions that will reward territory, contested ball, and defensive pressure. Both teams are above average with their contest work averaging more than 125 team contested possessions each week. Riddell have the upper hand in the clearance work with on average 2 more clearances than Macedon.

Expect a scrap, where the backlines could decide the outcome. For Macedon, Samantha Pointer and Brianna Woodburn will be pivotal in repelling Riddell’s barrage into the forward line, while reigning league best and fairest Ruby Watts and the classy Taya Konias will look to put the ball inside fifty to Charlotte Noonan and co’s as much as possible. For Riddell, Lauren Nolan will marshal the backline and must stand tall all game against Macedon’s potent attack. Ruby Taranto, Mariam Habib, and Mady Brown will have to nullify the Cats best while finding their own footy and Brianna De Haas and Ruby Ayers will need to capitalise on every scoring chance. Everything points to a fierce, low-scoring contest – one where the smallest moments could decide who raises the cup at the end of the game.

Prediction: Macedon by 8 points.



- Since 2019, the TYF program has been delivered to more than 10,000 participants in every Australian state and territory and it’s available to your club in 2024




