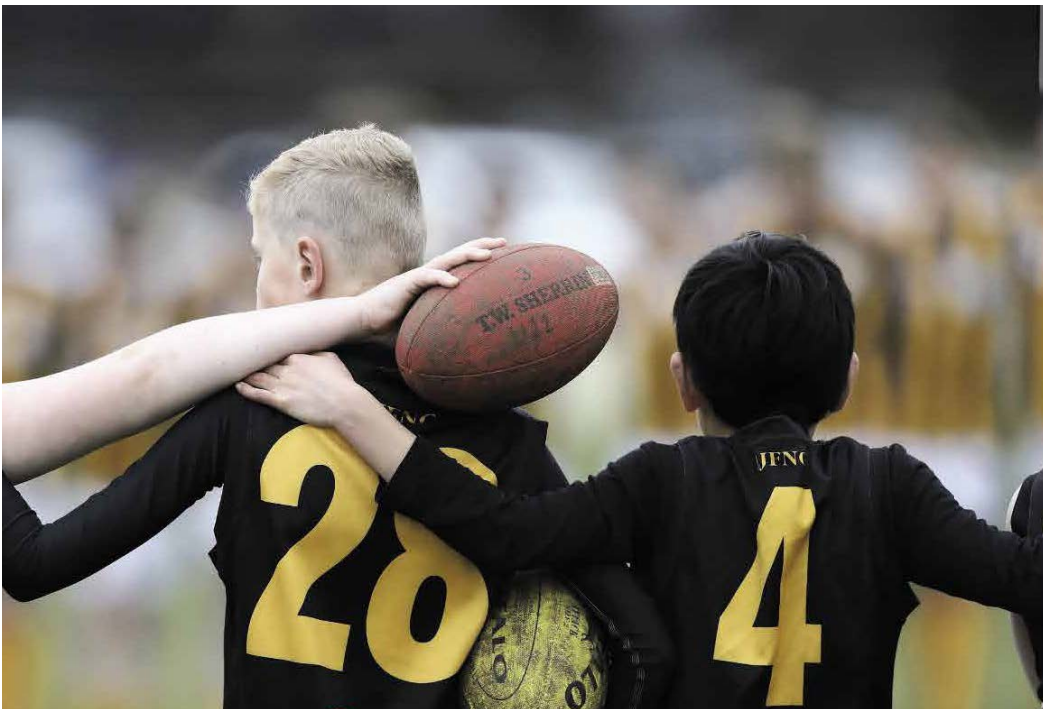

ROUND 2 RDFNL PREVIEWS with Grace Bibby

Diggers Rest vs Wallan

Diggers Rest and Wallan always come to play when they meet and this will be another big game for both clubs. Diggers Rest will unveil their premierships flags from season 2023 while Wallan will be looking to bounce back from a home ground defeat against Romsey, the first in nine seasons.

Diggers Rest will be bolstered by a few inclusions this week but they will be looking to tidy up in several key areas if they are to take the points.

For Wallan they will need to find four quarters of football this week. They had a dream start last week leading by 26 points but were unable to hold on.

From the Coaches:

Diggers Rest: Credit to Lancefield they really put the pressure on us. We made some errors and they made us pay. We were happy to get four points we know we have some work to do. Hopefully it was just the round one cobwebs and we can show some improvement this week. Wallan always play their best football against us and we will have to bring ours as well. They have some good players, Stewart is hard to stop due to his size and we know Morris gets a lot of it in the middle. We are looking forward to being in the new facilities and unfurling last year's flags in what should be a great day for the club.

Wallan: We started really well and had the momentum early. It's obviously disappointing to drop a 26 point lead after half time but full credit to Romsey who adapted in the third and got back in the game. Chris Stewart was amazing on debut. It's a challenging fixture with our next opponent being the reigning Premiers in Diggers Rest. They are always hard to beat at home but I will continue to back our boys in. We will have some key match ups however it will take a collective 22 player effort versus Diggers. They are well structured by Lobby and we look forward to another big contest. It's always a great game to be involved in.

Players to watch

Diggers Rest: Luke Delahey comes back into the Burras line up after missing round one.

Wallan: Young Owen Fowler received plenty of praise from his coach after his efforts down back in round 1.

Prediction: Diggers Rest to win Infront of a big home crowd.

Riddell vs Kyneton

Riddell and Kyneton each recorded wins in their opening round encounters.

Riddell have made plenty of changes in the offseason and have been labeled premierships favourites by many after some strong recruiting but some early injuries and a good showing from Macedon might have silenced the noise.

For Kyneton they have had a week to enjoy their successful start to their RDFNL campaign as they were big winners over last year's grand finalist Woodend Heskett. Kyneton will be looking to get a better start against the Bombers in their second hit out.

There will be a couple of key match ups to keep an eye on but there is probably none bigger than Galea versus Huntly.

From the Coaches:

Riddell: Macedon played really well. They structured up better than us I thought. We played a couple of really good patches and were lucky to get the four points. It is always nice to start with a win but from where we would like to be we are no where near it. We haven't played a lot of football together but one thing that shouldn't change is work rate. We have had a bit of a look at Kyneton and we have two big tests coming up. Like most clubs who played away we are looking forward to playing on our home ground and coming together with a function after it.

Kyneton: It was great to get the win. It took us a bit to get going but to be able to flick the switch was a positive sign for us. We think we have a little bit of improvement still to come but it is only round one. We know Riddell really filled out their list in the off season and it will be tough but we want to stick to our game plan. It is my old club so there is a little bit on the line for me and I am hopeful we are up to the challenge.

Players to watch

Riddell: Matthew Panuccio can pop up and snag a goal or two and with Tarczon injured their goals will need to come from somewhere.

Kyneton: Caleb Fisher has got himself in ripping condition as her returns from and ACL injury to be one of our round one players of the week.

Prediction: Riddell to continue to improve as they play more football together and get a close win over Kyneton.

Romsey vs Melton Centrals

For Melton Centrals they kicked back for the extra week and watched the rest of the competition as they had the bye.

We will get our first look at Melton Centrals this weekend.

Melton Centrals took the points from Romsey last season so this could be a contest well worth watching.

From the Coaches:

Romsey: It was a character-building win for us. They started hot and the way we responded and fought back will leave us in good stead this season. Everything we have been working on and practicing came to fruition. We are under no illusion though we need to play better football for more than just two quarters. We went back to the basics of winning the football, getting some spread and then got our ball flow going. We are unsure of Jack Jedwab's commitments and when he will play but we have to try and find other avenues to goal. Replacing 70 goals is never going to be easy. We are a really tight knit group and are confident if we have 22 playing and knowing their role we will be in a good position to challenge most teams. The RDFNL senior competition expects a lot each week and we want to continue to improve. The competition is just so even if you play a bad quarter, it could cost you.

Melton Centrals: It has been good to see how everyone else went in the first round. We have had some good results in practice matches but we have also been really short on numbers. How best football will be super competitive but we need to stay fit because we just don't have the depth of numbers. If anyone is looking for a game in the reserves please reach out to the club because not joking we may see our president playing this weekend. Romsey were quick and skillful in their first game we are not. We will need to take the pace of the game and try and slow them down. Hopefully we can find short targets and look after the football. That will give us the best chance of being in it.

Players to watch

Romsey: Christopher Petraro was our second player of the week for round 1 and his stat line showed plenty of heart up their with the best when it comes to one percenters.

Melton Centrals: The midfield battle will be crucial for the Blues as they have some of their top end in the middle led by James Roberts.

Macedon: Edward Ferguson, Joseph Barham and Lachie Hay have dominated juniors for a long time and now they are making waves at senior level.

TACKLE YOUR FEELINGS



Essendon are partnering with the Tackle Your Feelings (TYF) program to make mental health training available to community coaches, in 2022. Tackle Your Feelings is a free mental health training program for community AFL coaches, as well as committee members and other club support staff. The program is delivered by a local psychologist and aims to help participants gain the tools to Understand, Recognise and Respond to signs of mental ill-health in their players. In 2021, the program was delivered to more than 4000 community coaches from 352 clubs across every Australian state and territory. 'Tackle your Feelings' was inspired by mental health education developed for AFL professional coaches and players, consisting of a face-to-face presentation from a local psychologist and additional online learning. Ambassadors include Leon Cameron, Alastair Clarkson, Nathan Buckley, Neville Jetta, Kara Antonio and Dylan Buckley also feature throughout

the video content within the program. The program was formed by the AFL Coaches Association, AFL Players' Association and Zurich Insurance in 2018, after the tragic death of Adelaide coach Phil Walsh three years earlier.

How your club can get involved

Tackle Your Feelings is a free program and is available to your club in 2022.

Once coaches complete the training (workshop and online modules) they will have access to resources including blogs, podcasts and videos to assist with their ongoing learning. Participating clubs are eligible for the Tackle Your Feelings rewards program, which includes footballs, equipment and access to program ambassadors.

Firstly, I want to thank everyone for the kind words since my change in title last week. I am excited to take on new challenges and meet new people.

I am very lucky to work with such a supportive team at RDFNL HQ and in the greater RDFNL Board and Community.

I am looking forward to working closely with Hugh as he settles into the Football Operations Role.

With juniors starting this weekend and just one round of seniors completed a message that consistently comes from the RDFNL is to be kind at RDFNL Venues.

Many club coordinators have had issues over grading with parents, while umpires continue to have issues with players, coaches and spectators.

Use this as a friendly reminder that this is community sport and everyone should feel safe and have fun playing a sport we all love.

There's no denying that spectators are essential to sports. Without the active participation of

spectators and parents, clubs would struggle to find players, coaches, administrators, and umpires.

So if you witness any poor behaviour we ask you to call it out.

Poor parent sideline behaviour may include:

Foul language, threats or aggression directed toward the coach, umpire, player or even another parent.

Providing excessive instruction, or coaching from the sidelines. Often, in contrast to what the coach has instructed, generating confusion and embarrassment for players.

Put downs of a player's abilities, in private, or in front of others.

Parents demonstrating poor sportsmanship

When parents behave poorly at sporting matches, children are more likely to drop out of team sports. Furthermore, if you emphasise a 'winning is everything' attitude, you make the sport less fun, and more stressful for the child. Children are taught that mistakes are

not okay, and give up on trying for the fear of the consequences. Also, it's important for us to remember, and to remind our kids that mistakes are natural, and only make better players. Junior sports should be about socialising, keeping active and developing skills, but most importantly: having fun.

Blaming the umpire

When people blame an umpire for the result of a game, children learn to make excuses for outcomes. During a single match, thousands of decisions are made by umpires, coaches and players. So, to focus on one single decision made by an umpire, as the sole reason for the outcome of the game only teaches children how to absolve themselves of responsibility for their own actions. This leads to children who are less resilient, and who give up when facing adversity, for they feel they have no control over outcomes. Also, criticising the umpires sets an extremely bad example for children. Observing adults abusing an umpire teaches children that, they too may act disrespectfully towards authority figures. Once children learn a behaviour like this, it's common for the rude behaviour to carry over into other areas of their lives, including school, family, and even work later in life. It's also important to remember that umpires are often minors themselves, and only making calls they believe to be the fairest. They don't deserve the verbal abuse they are often at the receiving end of. If you have constructive criticism to offer, wait until the end of the game, and speak with your coordinator.

What should I do if I see another parent acting poorly on the sidelines?

It can be quite intimidating to witness another parent acting aggressively on the sidelines, and it's for this reason that you can't sit idly by. Also, if the behaviour makes you feel uncomfortable, imagine how frightening it is for your child and their teammates. Bring it up to the coordinator and stress how important addressing this behaviour is to you. Ultimately, they are responsible for the behaviour of their team's parent spectators and can impose penalties onto the child or the parent. Many clubs have policies to deal with abusive parents which may result in them being suspended or even banned from attending matches. You should not

turn a blind eye to this problematic behaviour that is creeping into the RDFNL. Remind other parents of the club's code of conduct, and the consequences of breaching this code. Often, if you privately call a parent out on their poor behaviour, you can curb it before it gets out of hand. Discourage toxic behaviours by making positive comments from the sidelines, and reminding other parents to focus on a child's strengths, and not their weaknesses. Try not to engage in complaining about coaches with other spectators. Often tempting, it can be a difficult habit to break, once started. If you feel you have legitimate concerns, arrange an appointment with the coach to discuss. Remember that coaches want the best for their teams, and should be receptive to easing your worries. Also, you should be respectful and positive towards the parents of the other team, and refrain from making negative comments about their players. When your child sees their parents exhibiting good sportsmanship, they are more likely to display it, too.

What is good sideline behaviour?

Many clubs have a code of conduct which specifies their expectations from parents and spectators during a match. It may be similar to the following recommendations:

Before and after each game remind your child that you're proud of them. No matter how they play.

Show support and encouragement to all players on the field.

Let the coach "coach", while you simply spectate and enjoy the game.

Honour the decision of the umpire. They make the call they believe to be the fairest.

Don't let the heat of the moment get to you. Ask yourself if your behaviour will embarrass your child, or yourself later.

Thank the coaches and referees for their commitment and effort. Most junior sports officials cite abuse from parents as the most stressful component of the job, which can lead them to quit.

Prioritise fun. Have fun yourself, and make sure your child enjoys the game too.

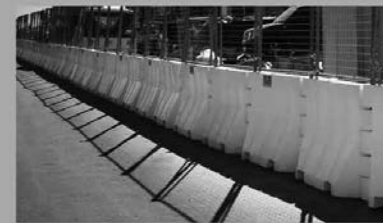

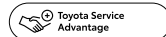
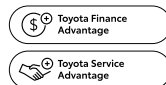
