## ROUND 3 RDFNL PREVIEWS

### with Grace Bibby

#### Kyneton vs Romsey

Kyneton have suffered their first loss in the RDFNL competition and will be forced to bounce back against Romsey.

Romsey are two wins from their two matches but both have been come from behind wins where they have found a way when most might have given up.

Kyneton will have to do it without their big man Jayden Eales who underwent scans earlier this week for a suspected ACL rupture.

#### From the Coaches:

**Kyneton:** It was a really tough result. Riddell really smothered us and we probably dropped our heads. We are a young group and they come out and kicked the first after the break and that was it. We have talked about shallow losses as a group but that was last week and we want to move on pretty quickly. We need to get back to our game style and make sure we are playing Kyneton football. We want to apply manic pressure that we have played in the BFNL and force turnovers. We are going to have to move the magnets around and some players will have to step up to cover the loss of Eales, but we want to be better than we were and are up for the challenge.

**Romsey:** We only just got over the line. Credit to Melton Centrals they were better than us for a big part of the day but credit to our guys we stayed in the contest. Its pleasing to be able to find a way. The hey for us is going to be how consistent we can be and how we find a way when we are not playing four quarters. Last season we lost a couple of close games early and it is something we have worked pretty hard to turn around and so far this season so good. We don't know too much about Kyneton but we can watch the footage and see they are physical but we pride ourselves on the contest and when we are playing the good sides in this competition that is something we don't want to shy away from. We will back in what we think works best for us and have a plan b if it is required.

#### Players to watch

**Kyneton:** Ethan Foreman would have been under the pump with selection trying to fill the void of Eales but he will also be wanting to put his best foot forward as the coach of a young team trying to bounce back.

**Romsey:** Darcy Lockens is a star on the rise in these competitions. He gets plenty of the football finds plenty of space and he often catches the eyes of opposition coaches.

**Prediction: Romsey to win in another tight finish.**

#### Melton Centrals vs Diggers Rest

Melton Centrals have pushed Romsey in their first game of the 2024 season. Despite falling short of victory they would have taken plenty of confidence out of the result and know they can match it when they are at their best.

#### From the Coaches:

Things like going down the line and getting it over the boundary line and resetting. Little things that are the difference when you play good teams. Noone really gave us a chance so to be competitive and be leading late shows us and everyone else we are not that far off it. It was a really good game of football and that would have shocked a lot of people. Last time we played Diggers Rest we were competitive. No doubt they are still one of the better teams in the comp but if we can play well we will be thereabouts. Jake Armistead is a huge loss for us and we hope he gets up this week but we will wait and see. It will be good to be at home and get back to the rooms for our first club function of the year.

**Diggers Rest:** There is no doubting we are annoyed with the loss. We asked for a response and we didn't fire a shot. It will be a tough week on the track but we need it. Areas we can control like effort just weren't there. The good thing is even though we didn't play well we still weren't disgraced. We just left too much work to do despite finishing with the scoring end. Wallan were very good. They always play their best footy against us and its pretty simple we weren't good enough on the weekend. Everyone knows you cant have a bad week in the RDFNL or you will cough up the four points. If previous results are anything to go by Melton Centrals will have our measure if we cant string four much better quarters together. They play their ground pretty well and have some dangerous players.

## TACKLE YOUR FEELINGS



Essendon are partnering with the Tackle Your Feelings (TYF) program to make mental health training available to community coaches, in 2022. Tackle Your Feelings is a free mental health training program for community AFL coaches, as well as committee members and other club support staff. The program is delivered by a local psychologist and aims to help participants gain the tools to Understand, Recognise and Respond to signs of mental ill-health in their players. In 2021, the program was delivered to more than 4000 community coaches from 352 clubs across every Australian state and territory. 'Tackle your Feelings' was inspired by mental health education developed for AFL professional coaches and players, consisting of a face-to-face presentation from a local psychologist and additional online learning. Ambassadors include Leon Cameron, Alastair Clarkson, Nathan Buckley, Neville Jetta, Kara Antonio and Dylan Buckley also feature throughout

the video content within the program. The program was formed by the AFL Coaches Association, AFL Players' Association and Zurich Insurance in 2018, after the tragic death of Adelaide coach Phil Walsh three years earlier.

### How your club can get involved

Tackle Your Feelings is a free program and is available to your club in 2022.

Once coaches complete the training (workshop and online modules) they will have access to resources including blogs, podcasts and videos to assist with their ongoing learning. Participating clubs are eligible for the Tackle Your Feelings rewards program, which includes footballs, equipment and access to program ambassadors.

Sportsmanship comes in many forms and helps make competitive games fun and enjoyable.

Being a good sport fosters good habits and positive life skills both in and out of sports games, and is an important life skill for people of all ages.

Last weekend across the RDFNL for saw a number of things take place that we want to remove from our league and competitions.

What Are the Qualities of Good Sportsmanship?

Sportsmanship is more than just being nice to others. There are a few main qualities that contribute to sportsmanlike behaviour:

1. Be supportive. If you're losing, it's best not to take your disappointment out on your teammates. Being a team player is essential during team sports, where support can mean everything. In a game, players are doing their best, and everyone wants to win. People are more productive and efficient with positive reinforcement, and a few words of encouragement or high-fives can sometimes be all someone needs to get their head back into the game.
2. Have a positive attitude. Having a negative attitude about the game can bring down the whole team, making competition less fun for everyone. Childish or inappropriate behaviour can dampen the spirit of the game and make players seem immature. Positivity is an important trait, especially when playing team sports.

3. Be respectful. Whether you win or lose, it's essential to show respect to others. Avoid being passive aggressive or insulting your peers over their gameplay. Even if you suspect someone of cheating, (which may not necessarily be the case), hurling harsh words at your opponents or teammates can damage your reputation, and the respect others have for you. Whining about calls or arguing with umpires also demonstrates unsportsmanlike conduct.
4. Be willing to learn. If you end up losing, rather than take it out on the opposition, try to learn from your mistakes. For instance, if you make a lot of forced errors during a tennis match, practice returning the balls that made you struggle the most. If you hit a lot of your backhands into the net instead of down the line winners, work on that technique to increase your chances of future success.
5. Practice self-control. Games can get emotional, but players should always make a conscious effort to control their emotions and focus on the game. Damaging sporting equipment or playing surfaces is a sure-fire way to be a bad sport and can also embarrass your teammates.

### Why Is Good Sportsmanship Important?

Good sportsmanship is important because it makes competitive play more enjoyable for everyone. While winning might feel like the most important thing during sporting events like tennis matches or basketball games, good sportsmanship teaches competitors how to be gracious and respectful towards others. Bad sportsmanship fosters a negative environment and can take the fun out of the game. Anyone can learn how to be a better sport while competing. Check out the following tips for displaying good sportsmanship:

1. Be a gracious winner. Being a sore loser when the other player or team wins isn't a good look, but neither is gloating over your win. Winning doesn't make one team more superior to the other; it means the winning team's skills and best efforts put them in the best position to win that game. You can be excited and happy for yourself for winning without taunting or putting down the opponents.
2. Play fair. Cheating at a game is poor sportsmanship. Fair play means having a level playing field. Every athlete or competitor has an equal opportunity to win, and no one has a more significant advantage or disadvantage over someone else. If you want to win at a game, everyone must start with the same conditions as the opposing team or player, and follow the rules of the game. Deviating outside of these guidelines may cause others to see you as a poor sport (including your team members), and no one will want to play with you in the next game.
3. Picture the future. Sometimes you'll have to compete against a friend, family member, or loved one, and it can be hard to put that relationship aside during competition and play a good game. Focusing on the future can help you get into the right mindset of competitive play.
4. Shake hands. It is customary of many sports to shake hands with the opposing player or team after a game.

Win or lose, shaking hands is a good sign of respect for the other people involved.

Folling the tragic event that shook the nation last Saturday lets keep in mind this weekend that there is a lot more to life than sport and while sport is critical in fostering great people it is not the be all and end all.



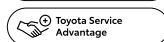
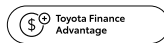
