Most senior players enjoyed a week off while there were a handful that suffered a heart breaking extra loss at the hands of Southern FNL.

We thank all coaches and players who made themselves available for our senior interleague program.

Kyneton vs Macedon

This is a winnable game for both teams and with four points hard to come by in the competition at the minute both teams will be ready to go.

There is a bit of a spice in this contest with the rivals just down the road from each other and a bit of history to go with it.

This should be a great game of football between two teams who haven't been out of games yet this season but haven't had as many wins as they would have liked.

From the Coaches:

Kyneton: It is great to be back out there. We have had a lean few weeks with the interleague and a bye and we are keen to put our best foot forward. They have a lot of really good players and we know there is fierce rivalry. We had a few injuries to start our season but we are hopeful through the middle of the season we get some players back and can start putting some good performances together.

Macedon: The games where you go in with even opportunity are really important. We want to make sure we get a good start. To start the season we have had lapses where we haven't been able to stem the bleeding while they have control of the football. Ideally you want to game played on your terms but when it isn't we let them get too far ahead and leave too much work to do. We feel we defend the ground really well we just need to keep finding ways to score. With Cookey coming back in this week we will have a bit more presence in the forward half.

Players to watch

Kyneton: Macedon: Jason Cooke comes back into the line up after being injured the past two matches.

Prediction: Macedon to win in a hard contested game

Riddell vs Melton Centrals

Both times these teams met last season it was a hard fought game. Melton Centrals were a much improved outfit to get the win over Lancefield while Riddell were ominous against Romsey.

Riddell have one of the strongest lists and when you add names like Tarczon, Cannon, Panuccio and Podolczak to the list the task for Centrals doesn't get any easier.

From the Coaches:

Riddell: We think Melton Centrals are better than their results suggest. They move the ball well and they have some good young kids. We are in a strong position as a club and we have been able to get wins on the board in our seniors and reserves. Everyone wants to be playing so we have a selection headache but it's a good headache to have. We want to keep our momentum going because it can turn around pretty quickly.

Melton Centrals: It is going to be interesting to see whether we have turned the corner or if it was a once off. We have changed our structure a bit and it worked against Lancefield. We have gone back to protecting ourselves a little more so we stay in games for longer. We are definitely not scared of playing Riddell we think if we can play well we will be thereabouts. But we have to come with the right attitude and play like a team.

Players to watch

Riddell: Dylan Tarczon is a big player who can change a match with a couple of kicks.

Melton Centrals: Dylan Jobson is fresh of a good performance against Southern FNL where he was named in the best for his three goal haul.



TACKLE YOUR FEELINGS



Essendon are partnering with the Tackle Your Feelings (TYF) program to make mental health training available to community coaches, in 2022. Tackle Your Feelings is a free mental health training program for community AFL coaches, as well as committee members and other club support staff. The program is delivered by a local psychologist and aims to help participants gain the tools to Understand, Recognise and Respond to signs of mental ill-health in their players. In 2021, the program was delivered to more than 4000 community coaches from 352 clubs across every Australian state and territory. 'Tackle your Feelings' was inspired by mental health education developed for AFL professional coaches and players, consisting of a face-to-face presentation from a local psychologist and additional online learning. Ambassadors include Leon Cameron, Alastair Clarkson, Nathan Buckley, Neville Jetta, Kara Antonio and Dylan Buckley also feature throughout

the video content within the program. The program was formed by the AFL Coaches Association, AFL Players' Association and Zurich Insurance in 2018, after the tragic death of Adelaide coach Phil Walsh three years earlier.

How your club can get involved

Tackle Your Feelings is a free program and is available to your club in 2022.

Once coaches complete the training (workshop and online modules) they will have access to resources including blogs, podcasts and videos to assist with their ongoing learning. Participating clubs are eligible for the Tackle Your Feelings rewards program, which includes footballs, equipment and access to program ambassadors.

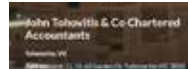

MEN'S FOOTBALL & NETBALL

It's a big occasion today for the clash of great rivals Lancefield and Romsey. We have been locking horns since 1879, even then the matches between the two great foes drew large crowds. Articles of the day expressed a wish that the players would 'keep their tempers and play friendly'. There was little chance of that. The report of the games in 1879 describes the 'anger, passions' and 'unpleasantness' of the game. There was a dispute between the two sides about the last goal that led to some unpleasantness that continued on after the game had finished. Prior to the game there was a proposal to amalgamate the two teams for a one off game against Kyneton or Kilmore but such was the bitterness between the clubs that the thought of playing together was too much to bear and the match was cancelled. It was just the beginning, the rivalry between the cross town rivals was such that things actually got worse!

Huge crowds attend each clash as the stories of the great rivalry spread. A report in 1901 suggests that unless the games between Lancefield and Romsey can be played in 'a more friendly spirit' then the games should be discontinued as 'football will be brought into disrepute, and very properly so too.' Perhaps they should have been discontinued because it appears things only get worse. In a 1907 game reports describe barrackers roaming all over the playing ground and turning into hordes of hoodlums as they brushed among the players shouting and yelling. In their return match the next month Lancefield refused to attend unless security were present, Romsey refused to pay for it so Lancefield held a whip around to pay for mounted police to attend the game. It's hard to imagine things getting any worse but when the Romsey goal umpire simply refused to signal a Lancefield goal it set everyone off. The mood between the teams

is best summed up in a report of 1910 stating that, 'this club bears not an atom of friendship towards the Lancefield club.'

The hatred goes on for generations, the match report of the 1945 bloodbath must rank as one of the most incredible pieces of football journalism ever written. It describes the 'fisticuffs and free use of boots', Bruce Waller being taken to hospital after receiving 'undue attention', brawls breaking out all over the ground before a supporter, having seen his brother punched, jumped the fence and belted the offending player with what was described as being a 'good washer womans swing'. At this point police take over the game and the supporter having been removed from the oval is then given a jumper and takes the place of the absent Waller on the field! A letter to the editor from the Romsey captain lists all the players on his side that were knocked out. The umpire W Edwards is described as having done 'a splendid job.' You have to wonder if he ever did another game? Carlton and Collingwood are left looking like kissing cousins next to these two.

Thankfully relations have improved greatly between these two clubs but it's still the great traditional clash in the RDFNL. These games are marked in everyone's calendar when the fixture is released at the start of the year but today's game has an extra element to it with our great rivals, Romsey, celebrating their 150th anniversary. From all of us at the Lancefield Football Netball Club we pay tribute today to Romsey on your great achievement. Not just everyone at the club today but also the generations that have come before to get you where you are today. There's no-one we'd rather beat but at the same time there is no-one we would miss more if you weren't around. Congratulations and we hope our great rivalry will continue for another 150 years.

Without umpires there is no community sport and it is time to show our appreciation for what they do and the fact that they put up their hand to contribute to everyone being able to play.

Sports is so important for so many lives and we need to continue to support our umpires so we can continue to play.

Participating in sport programs is a regular part of growing up, for most of us in Australia. Physical activity is essential for healthy and optimal development,

through childhood and early adulthood, and youth and adult sports provide many opportunities.

The key benefits of sport include;

Providing a positive outlet where kids can spend their free time which can also help relieve boredom; one of the biggest factors in youth crime. Recreation and sport events can be a great facilitator for engagement and interaction, helping build stronger bonds within your neighbourhoods. There is no second family like your netball team and club mates.

Improving physical health; We all know that recreation, sport events and

keeping physical health in tip-top shape are among the best things we can do for our overall health. Even activities such as going for a brisk walk and other moderately aerobic activities are deemed fairly safe and effective for most people.

Immediate health benefits include:

1. Better sleep quality
2. Less anxiety
3. Reduced blood pressure

Long-term health benefits include:

1. Reduced risk of developing dementia
2. Lowered risk of heart disease
3. Heightened cancer prevention
4. Weight management
5. Improved bone strength
6. Reduced risk of falls through improved balance

In general, Health experts recommended 150 minutes of moderate activity per week to lower the risk of all-cause mortality by up to 33% so if you train once or twice a week with your chosen club and play one or two games you are hitting that goal.

Learning new life skills; Sporting Clubs open a number of opportunities and pathways for people who have aspirations to work within sport. You can start umpiring for pocket money or you can help in an official role and get an inside into sports management.

Maybe you are more attracted to numbers and figures and could assist the treasurer. Or maybe a budding journalism career could start writing the record notes.

Volunteers are so hard to come by and it is experience that could separate you from your peers. One of the best things you can do as a youth or an adult is join a board or committee. It's a great way to realise that games of netball don't just happen. There is so much work that goes into every decision at team level, club level and league level. By putting yourself in official roles at the club you will have a greater understanding and appreciation of what goes on behind the scenes.

Community sport provides a place for all ages to enjoy a common interest in a safe environment.

If nothing else just enjoy being on court and leave your poor behaviour at home.

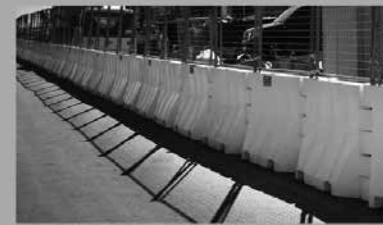
