Diggers Rest vs Riddell

Both teams have had great starts to their season and have been touted as the teams to beat. Riddell have the perfect record they will want to keep in tact but Diggers Rest are the reigning premiers and will have plenty to prove.

From the Coaches:

Diggers Rest: You never really know if you have done enough or gone too hard when you have a break. We feel like we are ready and we know it will be a tough contest. They have talent on every line but we feel like we do as well. I don't think we have played our best football as a group yet but I also don't think Riddell have either it will be a great indication for both teams and we are sure it will be an exciting contest.

Riddell: We are happy to get the win but we are happy with how we played probably not. We played really well in the last quarter but credit to Melton Centrals we couldn't get any speed on the game and it was lucky our defence stood up as well as they did. TACKLE YOUR FEELINGS



Essendon are partnering with the Tackle Your Feelings (TYF) program to make mental health training available to community coaches, in 2022. Tackle Your Feelings is a free mental health training program for community AFL coaches, as well as committee members and other club support staff. The program is delivered by a local psychologist and aims to help participants gain the tools to Understand, Recognise and Respond to signs of mental ill-health in their players. In 2021, the program was delivered to more than 4000 community coaches from 352 clubs across every Australian state and territory. 'Tackle your Feelings' was inspired by mental health education developed for AFL professional coaches and players, consisting of a face-to-face presentation from a local psychologist and additional online learning. Ambassadors include Leon Cameron, Alastair Clarkson, Nathan Buckley, Neville Jetta, Kara Antonio and Dylan Buckley also feature throughout

the video content within the program. The program was formed by the AFL Coaches Association, AFL Players' Association and Zurich Insurance in 2018, after the tragic death of Adelaide coach Phil Walsh three years earlier.

How your club can get involved

Tackle Your Feelings is a free program and is available to your club in 2022.

Once coaches complete the training (workshop and online modules) they will have access to resources including blogs, podcasts and videos to assist with their ongoing learning. Participating clubs are eligible for the Tackle Your Feelings rewards program, which includes footballs, equipment and access to program ambassadors.

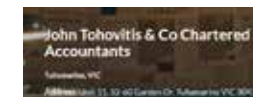
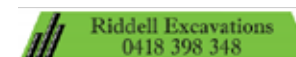

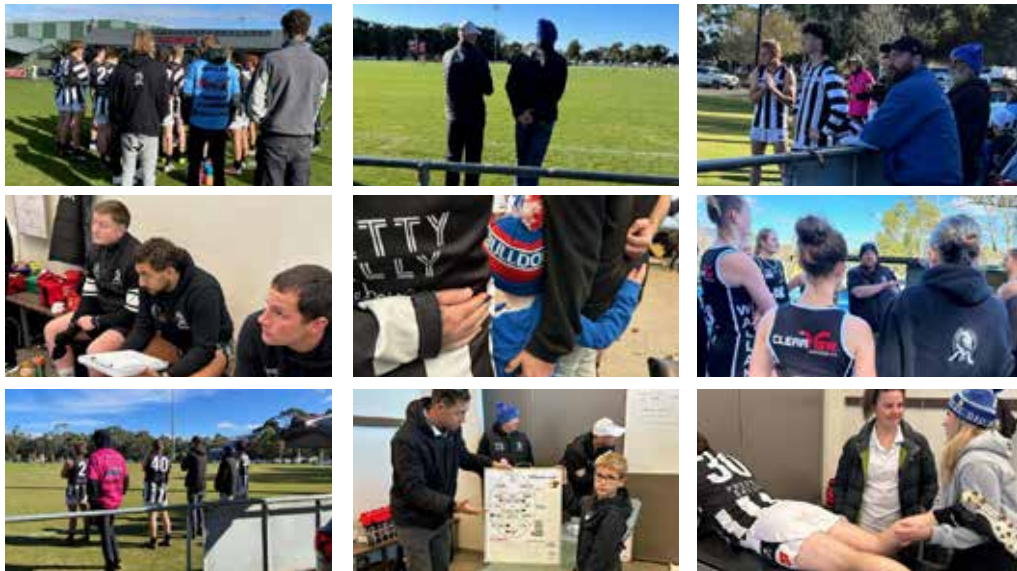

The Gisborne Giants Indigenous jumper and dress design, aims to promote learning, awareness, and respect through storytelling to the club's playing groups, their families, and supporters. Key highlights of the design are its references to Wurundjeri Country and the bushlands surrounding Gisborne, including the sacred 'Macedon Ranges sites'. It honours and respects the history and spirit of sacred Wurundjeri lands. Highlighting that we live, play, and learn on traditional country. The blue linework symbolises the beautiful waterways that flow throughout Wurundjeri Country. The Central Meeting Place celebrates the community at Gisborne Giants, highlighting unity and a welcoming space. Honouring all the players, parents, volunteers, coaches, and supporters that play their part to make the club what it is.

The Gisborne Giants welcomes and respects all people, regardless of background, and we are committed to supporting all cultures that shape our community. We are thrilled to staging Mundanai Round and look forward welcoming the Gisborne community to be part of it.

This Friday night, the Giants U19.5s eagerly anticipate their upcoming clash against Romsey. This special occasion promises to be a celebration of culture, unity, and the rich history of Indigenous Australians in sport. As they prepare to take the field once again, the Giants carry the momentum from their hard-fought win, against Diggers Rest ready to honour tradition and showcase their skills in a match that holds great significance for the club and the community.

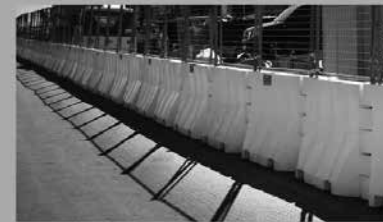
