Drawn Finals (Football)

In the event of a draw, the following will apply;

- The teams will change ends following a break of no more than three minutes.
- A five minute quarter will be played before immediately changing ends for another five minute quarter. There is to be no break between these quarters.
- If at the end of the second five minute quarter, the scores are still level, no change of ends will occur, play will be restarted at the centre bounce and the first score will win.

Drawn Finals (Netball)

In the event of a draw, the following will apply;

- The teams will change ends following a break of four minutes. This allows scores to be verified.
- Teams will play two periods of extra time stopping for one minute inbetween to make changes and swap ends.

- The extra time periods is half a normal quarter. In the event of an odd number round down. (For example, 10 minutes quarters play 5 additional minutes each end. 15 minute quarters play 7 additional minutes each end.
- If at the end of two extra time periods the game is still level play continues until one team has a two goal advantage. The siren or horn does not sound.

Post Match Presentations

Following the final siren of netball and football please head directly to the presentation stage. Please note no parents should be entering the playing arena. This will allow RDFNL to stick to tight timing with games commencing while presentations are happening.

UNDER 11C Woodend Vs Gisborne Giants

It was clear heading into finals that these two sides were the best sides in the competition and now they face off in the grand final. Woodend were undefeated during the season and beat the giants twice by seven and seventeen points. However, Woodend's undefeated streak was halted in the first final where Gisborne won the game by 8 points in a massive upset win. Gisborne have had an up and down season losing a few games to lower ranked sides, but it seems they're peaking at the right time which sets up for an intriguing clash. Woodend have the league runner up best and fairest Charlie Podbury at their disposal who will be a massive factor in this game and Toby Carey will also be an important player in attack who kicked 7 goals in 12 games finishing fifth in the league goalkicking for the year. For the Giants they have Anderson Hayward who finished third in the league best and fairest, he had a great game in the first final between these two and he will need another good performance here to get his team over the line.

UNDER 11B Riddell Vs Kyneton

A dominant undefeated season for Riddell who will be favourites in this one, they're closest game however came two weeks ago against Kyneton who they only beat by 8 points in the qualifying final. Kyneton are fresh off a straight sets score with only a 5-point win against the Kangaroos in the prelim final, they'll have confidence going into this one and believe they can upset Riddell who have been the benchmark all year. Riddell are strong everywhere across the ground, they will be led however by Ted Besanko who finished third in the league best and fairest with 18 votes, Lennox Lambert will also be important for Riddell who has been their main goalkicker this year kicking 10 goals in 10 games. Kyneton will rely heavily on their league best and fairest winner Corey Plowman, he's had an incredible year polling 23 votes and winning the league goalkicking with 22 goals in 11 games. Not far behind him and nearly equally important will be Jack Hourigan who finished sixth in the league best and fairest and was named in the best 10 out of the 11 games he's played this season.

UNDER 11A Gisborne Rookies Vs Woodend

The second year straight these two clubs have faced off in the Under 11A grand finale. The rookies have had a flawless season finishing 13-0 without anyone really coming close to them and you'll think they'll be heavy favourites leading into this one. The Hawks have had two strong final performances heading into this game, they smashed Melton Bloods by 43 points and then last week won easily against second place South by 26 points. They'll obviously be underdogs heading into this game already losing to the Rookies by 34 points during the season, but they'll know anything can happen in finals. The Rookies star studded team will be led by league best and fairest James Walker who polled a perfect 9 votes in the last 3 rounds securing the win, he is a future superstar and will be vital to the Rookies securing a perfect season in this game. Woodend will be led by Sebastian Cavric who finished second in the league best and fairest just behind James Walker by 1 vote, Cavric also won the league goalkicking kicking 21 goals in 12 games.

Under 13C Woodend Vs Gisborne Giants

A bit of an interesting matchup this one, the Giants went through the whole season undefeated with no one coming within 25 points of them including Woodend where they beat them by 46 points. Remarkably in the qualifying final Gisborne Giants didn't score and Woodend won by 33 points, a crazy result which many wouldn't have expected setting up a competitive grand finale. Woodend were dominant against most sides except Gisborne during the season where they won every game except their sole loss to the Giants. Their performance in the qualifying final will no doubt give them confidence but I think they'll verse a stronger Gisborne side this time around and they'll have to be ready for that. The Giants are well rounded, and they have several good players around the ground, they had 5 of the top 8 players in the league best and fairest including Max Sadler who finished second. Up forward Jacob Telfer has been the Giants main target kicking 22 goals from 11 games and I'm sure he will add to his tally on the big stage come Sunday. The

Hawks are led by league best and fairest winner Jack Brady who made a late charge to win the award, he'll have to be a big factor once again come Sunday if the Hawks do get the win. Finn Brosnan and Harry Stapleton will also be threats as they finished fourth and fifth respectively in the goalkicking with 12 and 11 goals each.

Under 13B Romsey Vs Diggers Rest

The Burras dream finals run continues but this week against their hardest opponent yet. That opponent is the Romsey Redbacks who are looking to complete the perfect undefeated season and will go into this game as hot favourites. The Redbacks haven't played against the Burras since round 5 where they won by 21 points and whilst being undefeated, they have had some close calls including their 4-point win over the Centrals in the qualifying final two weeks ago. The Burras enter this game full of confidence, they've only lost 2 games during the year to Melton Centrals and Romsey. And after knocking off Melton Centrals in the prelim by 7 points, they know anything can happen and I think they have it in them to pull off an upset here. Romsey will no doubt be led by Blake Marienfeld who finished equal fifth in the league best and fairest whilst also booting 18 goals in 11 games for the season, he among some of his other teammates also represented the league in the interleague carnival. One of those teammates was Cooper Stevens who will be their main man in attack booting 27 goals from 13 games this season including 2 in there qualifying final. The Burras have the services of Hayzen Denko who also finished equal fifth in their league best and fairest and Blake Steele a strong forward who won the league goalkicking by 18 goals with 43 majors in 12 games.

Under 13A Woodend Vs Gisborne Giants

The depth of these two clubs U13 programs is really on showcase here with another U13's grand final between these two teams. Woodend finished the season 11-1 and second on the ladder, their only loss came to the Giants during the season by six points however the Hawks got their revenge beating the Giants by 18 points in the qualifying final. The Giants finished the season 12-1 with their sole loss coming to Woodend earlier in the season by five points, after this game the Hawks have had a number on the Giants beating them twice in a row. The giants also nearly suffered a straight sets exit last week only just beating the Rookies by four points in the preliminary final. Woodend's side are extremely well rounded, there aren't any real standouts, but Angus Soppe is a highly important player for them through the middle, he finished fourth in the league best and fairest voting. James O'Connor is also having a great year for the Hawks winning the league goalkicking with 18 goals in 9 games. For the Giants their midfield is their biggest asset, Sam Wellinton and Lachlan Greenwood have been vital to the Giants success this season. Wellington won the league best and fairest with a dominant season where he also impacted the scoreboard kicking 15 goals in 12 games. Greenwood has been a handy pick up for the Giants, one of the smallest but most courageous players out there that can take a good mark for his size.

Under 15C Melton Vs Lancefield

The fifth matchup of the year between these two. It's been a strong year for the Melton Bloods finishing 10-4 with only two of their losses coming after grading against Lancefield losing by 38 and 17 points. It's been a weird matchup when the Bloods and the Tigers have played, whilst on paper, they're so evenly matched in the four games they've played against each other this year they've both won twice mainly by considerable margins. Melton's two wins against Lancefield have come in grading by 5 points and their massive performance in the qualifying final with a 27-point win. Lancefield also finished the season 10-4 and hadn't lost a game since round four until they dropped the qualifying final. Their two wins against Melton during the year and their dominant 37-point win over Eynesbury in the prelim is sure to give them confidence in the rematch and it sets up an awesome clash. Melton will be led by Hunter Henderson and Slater Byrne who finished second and third in the league best and fairest night, Slater also finished third in the league goalkicking with 29 goals in 11 games. Lancefield have the league best and fairest winner Jackson Hardham at their disposal.

an in and under ball winner who will need to perform well if they win this game. Tyler Caddie through the ruck and forward line is also one to watch, he's kicked 27 goals in 12 games this season.

Under 15B Melton South Vs Riddells Creek

On paper this probably looks like Melton South's grand final to lose. Riddells Creek has had an incredible finals series, it's not often you see a team that finished fourth in the grand final so it's a great achievement for them. Riddell finished 6-6 for the year with also 2 draws, they did beat two of the teams above them during the season but weren't able to get close to South either of the times they played losing by 32 and 24 points. The Panthers finished the season 9-5 with only 2 losses after grading, their 2 losses to second and third on the ladder indicates they can be beaten but the Panthers will take confidence out of their positive record against Riddell during the year. Riddells Creek will no doubt be led by league best and fairest winner Ryan Farrugia, an in and under midfielder who can also impact the scoreboard kicking 15 goals in 12 games this year. Seth May up forward will also be handy; he's kicked 16 goals in 13 games this year and has been named in the best players 10 times. The Panthers will be led by the Newbold's, Jax finished first and Zayn finished second in the league goalkicking this year and Jax kicked 6 goals in two games against Riddell this season. William Verlander through the midfield will also be important, he finished fourth in the league best and fairest voting.

Under 15A Gisborne Rookies Vs Woodend

This will probably be one of the most high-quality junior grand finals you will see, there are talented players everywhere across both teams which sets up an exciting clash. Gisborne Rookies year has been quite extraordinary, 14-0 for the season and a percentage more than 800% higher than anyone else. They played Woodend twice during the season and won both by 78 and 46 points, however Woodend nearly pulled off one of the biggest upsets in the qualifying final against the Rookies with it only being a 1pt margin at three quarter time, but the Rookies managed to win by 9 points. Woodend have also had a strong season finishing second with a 9-5 record, they were inconsistent at times but their recent qualifying final performance against the Rookies and their nail-biting preliminary final win over Melton last week indicates they are fit and firing now. The rookies will be led by Taylan Towers, a highly talented midfielder who finished fourth in the league best and fairest and won a best on ground medal in the under 15A's interleague carnival earlier on in the year. Talented, forward Zachary Lockens will also be a key factor for the rookies, he kicked 27 goals in only 10 games played this year. Woodend will be led by Jake Curcio an extremely versatile player that can take a strong mark in pivotal moments of the game, he finished third in the league best and fairest and finished third in the league goalkicking. Ben Sumpter is another key part of Woodend's midfield and is one to watch, a bottom ager that doesn't look out of place in A grade footy.

Under 17B Gisborne Rookies Vs Gisborne Giants

These two cross town rivals have been the benchmark of this division all season and now it all comes down to this. The Rookies finished the season 9-4 with only 1 loss coming after grading to the Giants, it's the fourth matchup between these two teams and Rookies have been able to win three of them now including the qualifying final where they won by eight points. I'm still in disbelief on how the Giants won that prelim final against Lancefield to be in this game, they didn't kick a goal until nearly halfway through the fourth quarter and managed to pull back a 19-point 3 quarter time deficit winning the game by 3 points. The Giants to win this game will have to be better than they have been the last two weeks, losing to the Rookies in week 1 and nearly dropping the prelim against Lancefield is a worry and they will need to turn things around quickly here. The Rookies are a really well-balanced side, they had 3 of the top 8 in the league best and fairest including Connor Marsden who is one to watch on Saturday, another one to watch is Seamus Sullivan who has had an extraordinary year kicking 58 goals in 12 games double more than anyone else in the competition. The Giants strong U17 program means their depth of good players extends into their B's side, Aiden

Magris finished third in the league best and fairest and spent some time with the A grade side during the year, his pace through the midfield is what could win the Giants this game.

Under 17A Gisborne Giants Vs Sunbury Kangaroos

If this games anything like the qualifying final it will be a thriller. Gisborne Giants have been the benchmark of this U17 competition, 14-0 and elite players everywhere means they will go into this game as heavy favourites. They've played the Kangaroos three times now and interestingly it's become closer each time they've played. The first game was an 111-point margin, the next was 55 and finally in the qualifying final they only won by 20 points. The Sunbury Kangaroos have also had a great year, they enter another 17A grand final hopefully this time looking for a win. They got a jump on the Giants in the first quarter in the qualifying final where it looked like a massive upset was on, however the Giants clowned them back and got the win. The Kangaroos also just got it done against the Rookies last week and with some injury clouds around their best players these hard games aren't going to help. 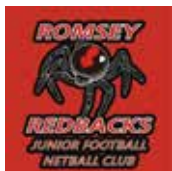
